




WELCOME, "DAR ON THE ROAD


Please continue your prayers for electricity to be supplied to DAR Station KDHP 91.9 FM which is ready and waiting to begin broadcasting!



John Boyd, Jr., Champion Team Roper and break-away roper, received a GodPod from Diné Adventist Radio editor Kietel Jones. Boyd, Jr. is a lifelong rodeo competitor based on the Navajo Nation. He had long wished to hear Scripture in his native tongue. The GodPod preloaded with the entire Bible—Old Testament in Navajo, New Testament in English—immediately became a prized possession.

At every rodeo, Boyd, Jr. tucks the GodPod into his saddlebag and carries it with him to the stables. While tending his horses, he presses play on the compact device and listens to passages in Navajo. Fellow Navajo cowboys often wander over, curious about the audio emanating from his trailer. Boyd, Jr. simply turns up the volume, and the group gathers on hay bales to hear familiar verses in a fresh way.

Moved by the impact this small player has had on his friends, Boyd, Jr. is now requesting additional GodPods in Navajo. He hopes that each cowboy on the reservation can carry the Word of God with them—whether they're in the arena or on the range.
