

## ~~CALL FOR EARNEST PRAYER~~


The following text message came this week from Pastor Dale Wolcott, Diné Adventist Radio prayer coordinator: "Keep praying that God will cut red tape holding up electric hookup to our full-power FM tower which is ready to reach 60,000 listeners at the center of the Reservation. Just lacking 180 feet of power line. The BIA official who must sign is away." This tower is for station KDHP 91.9 FM which is on Black Mesa, near Piñon and Chinle, Arizona. After the Bureau of Indian Affairs signature is obtained, final approval will come from the Navajo Tribal Utility Authority!

The July/August issue of "Adventist Journey" featured Diné Adventist Radio. The article reported the March 19, 2025 opening of FM station KDHH 89.5 FM as a "quiet but powerful breakthrough for a project years in the making." The airwaves above Kaibeto, Arizona began providing listeners



with "a message of hope." Pastor Dale Wolcott, who has served as a pastor to the Navajo Nation since 1990, stated "After 100 years of Adventist work among the Navajo people, they are still an unreached people group.... Radio is going places we could never reach otherwise."

Reading 'between the lines' we can discover our part in the story! The plan calls for Diné Adventist Radio to build "a network of three full-power and four low-power FM stations." Praise the Lord, Bisti Broadcasting will be one of those stations!

Already, people are listening and responding. A recent program offering free GodPod devices loaded with bilingual content prompted 14 responses in just two minutes. Bible study requests continue to roll in from across the region.

"One signal is live. More are coming. The desert is listening."





## GodPod Story

Gleaned from DAR "Navajo Waves"



Pastor Jackson Williams of Piñon Gospel Church, recently found the DAR signal on 89.5 FM. That broadcast comes from KDHH broadcasting 84-miles away in Preston Mesa. He heard the offer to receive a GodPod on one of the broadcasts. Pastor Eric Bahnmiller from Window Rock recently delivered a GodPod to Williams who wanted to listen to some books in his Native Navajo language and in English.

Williams, who is visually impaired and accustomed to studying Scripture through his braille Bible, now carries a portable audio Bible that presents the Old Testament entirely in Navajo and the New Testament in English. After pressing play on the device, Williams found Revelation—his favorite prophetic book.
