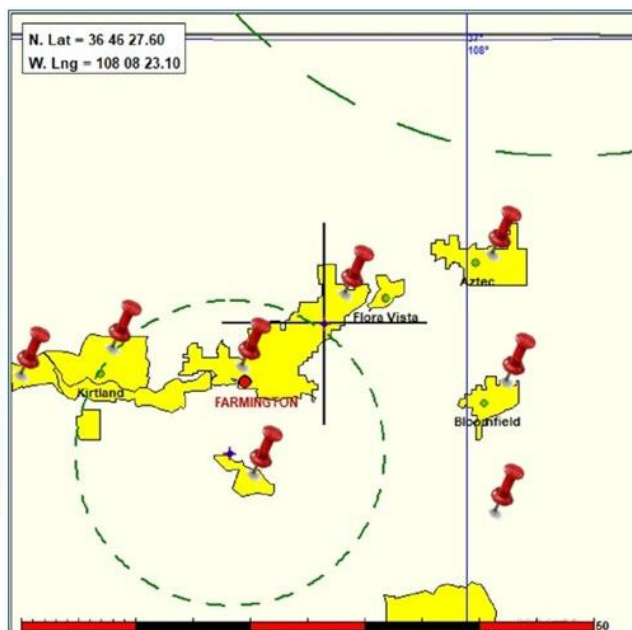


## "On The Air!!"

Hallelujah!! Our prayers have been answered. Bisti Broadcasting is "On The Air!!"

At 7:45 p.m. on August 13, 2026 the Adventist World Radio (AWR) engineers made the final connection and the programming from Diné Adventist Radio (DAR) began sounding over the airwaves above Farmington! Prayers of thanksgiving and much rejoicing took place at Piñon Hills SDA Church. The day of final preparations had started at 8:00 AM and as the day stretched on Bisti board member, Tamara, said it was "like waiting for a baby to be born!"

The waiting had already started on December 13, 2023 when the newly incorporated Bisti Broadcasting board applied for a permit to build an LPFM radio station. The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) permit was issued on February 9, 2024 with a three-year deadline for construction completion. During the stretch of months between permit and completion there have been many challenges. The faithful "saints" at Piñon Hills and Aztec SDA churches have prayed, volunteered, donated and rejoiced as each requirement was accomplished. The original map of expected coverage submitted to the FCC has already been exceeded with reports of clear broadcasts being heard at points beyond the anticipated signal reach. On the map below, note "check in" markers outside the expected circle! Interested listeners have already called in with prayer and Bible Study requests! Now we can continue giving, sharing and praying for God to use Bisti Broadcasting as a mighty witness sharing His love with precious souls in the Navajo Nation and throughout the Four Corners area!



# Multiple Blessings

In the August 2026 Rocky Mountain NewsNuggets, an article entitled “Two New Missionaries Stand Tall in the Rocky Mountain Conference”. The article covers the news of not only Bisti Broadcasting’s going “on the air” but also of KJSS-LP ~ the station established by the Waterflow SDA church ~ which started broadcasting a day earlier. Engineers from Adventist World Radio (AWR) traveled all the way from Maryland to finish the work on both stations. They made the final adjustments, and then on August 12 and 13 both stations came alive on the air with programming from the Diné Adventist Radio Network (DAR).

The article stated “The Rocky Mountain Conference (RMC) had two new missionaries start their work in August. These missionaries will never take a vacation, never call in sick, and never get tired of sharing the good news of Jesus.

They stand tall day and night through sun, wind, rain, snow, and cold. Their voices carry hope across the high desert, reaching people in Shiprock, Farmington, and nearby communities.

These Missionaries are two radio towers.”

Only days after the stations went “on the air” both received calls from new listeners ~ asking for prayer and Bible studies. “The gospel message is already reaching hearts. The seed has been planted and God is already working. These steel missionaries are already doing what they were built to do.”
