TNCJ AIM MMVV

(MISSION, MOTTO, VISION, VALUES)

The word "**coalition**" finds its etymological origins in the Latin word "coalescere," which means "to grow together" or "to unite." It is a combination of "co-" (meaning "together") and "alescere" (meaning "to grow" or "to increase") (www.betterwordsonline.com)

The work of **TNCJ AIM** is the **collaboration of all 5 core auxiliaries, growing together** through shared insight, ideation, and cooperation, **culminating in an annual jurisdictional convention** that provides well-trained, effective jurisdictional representatives to the international departments during the international AIM convention.

MISSION: The MISSION of the AIM Coalition is to **collaborate with auxiliary leaders** to **cultivate ideas** and **activities** that will **advance the vision of the bishop**, help build the **capacity** and **potency** of each department to **support the local church**, and culminate in a jurisdictional AIM convention that **highlights and promotes each auxiliary** and prepares and assists participants to represent the jurisdiction well at the international AIM convention.

VISION: The VISION of the AIM Coalition is to:

- Ensure that **every local church** has **active** and **viable** Evangelism, Mission, Music, Sunday School, and Youth Departments supported by **recurring training** and **functional activities**.

- Have **award-winning jurisdictional representatives** that excel in the international AIM convention, which will **highlight the level of commitment to ministry cultivated** in the churches of the Texas North Central Jurisdiction

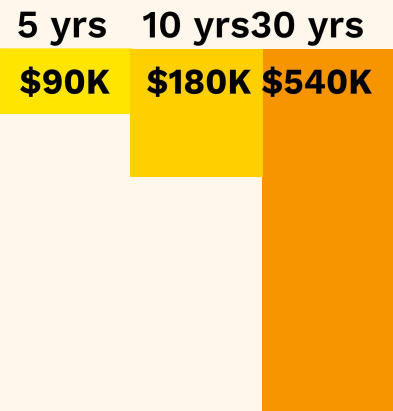
Stop Paying Rent. Start Building A Future.

It also builds stability, equity, and long-term wealth for you and your family. **Equity is the portion of your home's value that belongs to you. 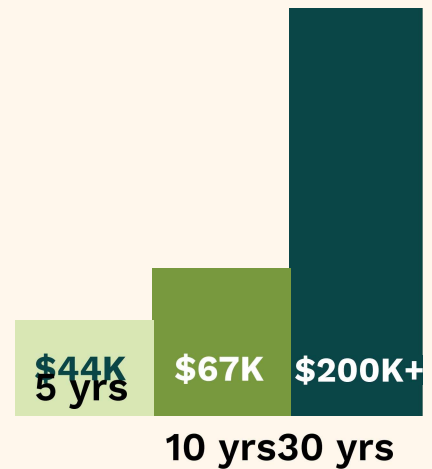
