INTRODUCTION

DISCUSSION

The Apostle Paul admonished believers to be transformed by the renewing of their minds, for he understood that it is with the mind that the believer serves God.



DISCUSSION

People are receiving better and more education, which opens up the opportunity for better jobs in various places, leading to migration to other cities and communities.



DISCUSSION

Believers cannot live for yesterday, as yesterday has passed, nor can they live for the future, as it is not promised to them. The only moment in time that they have is right now. They only have today, so they must change their perspective and think What can we do today? If a believer can change today, he can change his entire life. Believers can and should always change things in their world for the better, for they are change agents and have been empowered with power from on high.



DISCUSSION

Daniel's life was full of changes. As a young man, he was taken captive from his home and all the things that were familiar to him. He had to learn, with the help of God and the prayer life he had developed, to be flexible in the changing world that he had become a part of. He learned to thank God for wisdom and might as he learned that God could and did change times and seasons. God is so powerful that He sets up and removes kings.



DISCUSSION

The story of the Tower of Babel is one of a profound change. At the beginning of the story, men all over the known world spoke the same language and had one speech. They decided to build a tower that would reach into Heaven and make a name for themselves. They got together and they began to build. Everyone cooperated, and things were going fine. The people were so together that they got God's attention, and He decided to go down to see the city they were building. When God saw that the people had joined together as one, He decided that He must do something to stop them.



DISCUSSION

At the time of the building of the tower, there was only one language, which all men spoke.
