

Your community provides its own drinking water and you can help protect it. Know where your well is located and how the land around it is being used. There is a connection between land and groundwater. What we do on the land impacts the water we drink.

How you can help:

- Get to know your watershed or groundwater recharge area.
- Use and dispose of hazardous materials properly.
- Be Septic Smart! Flush only bath tissue and put oil and grease in the trash, not the sink.
- When using fertilizers and pesticides, follow the directions and apply only what you need.
- Conserve water whenever you can.
