

Facilities (Anne Stanley)

As part of our near-term safety improvements, you may have noticed that the lights on the clubhouse have been modified to provide better illumination of the parking lot. Soon the team will be installing some walkway lights to provide better visibility on the paths. Additionally, cameras for the front of the clubhouse have been ordered, and will be installed once received. Next year, purchase and installation of rails for the clubhouse area steps will be completed as further safety enhancements along the walkways.

Because we're a new committee, we recently drafted an approach for addressing the maintenance costs and purchase requests associated with the clubhouse, courts, fitness, and pool and hot tub facilities. This year will be a time for us to establish a baseline budget and to put in place processes to help manage and maintain our assets. We plan to monitor and regulate our heating and cooling and will be managing the clubhouse temperature throughout the year and working with activity leads to ensure adjustments are made when needed for events and large gatherings.

We're meeting with the vendor in early January to get further insight on the programming of the thermostats and will be installing covers to help ensure consistent temperatures are maintained. In addition, we'll be finally adding some blinds to the windows, and will plan in the upcoming year to add more.

On the subject of fitness and courts, we expect to work with our racquet sport players to establish an approach for preserving the life of our windscreens and nets during the winter months. Due to extreme wind conditions, the windscreens have already been removed to avoid further tearing. We'll be addressing the nets next. We'll also re-evaluate our court reservation system as the current tool is no longer offering a 'free' level of service. For the fitness enthusiasts, we'll be meeting with our fitness vendor in January and discussing several potential improvements to both the fitness equipment and the space.

Finally, as a reminder to all homeowners and permanent residents, we need to ensure everyone is familiar with the HOA rules regarding fitness and court usage by guests. Court guests must be accompanied by a homeowner or permanent resident (19 years of age or older), and no guests are allowed in the fitness room due to liability risks. A goal is to not clutter the community with lots of signs, ensure our community adheres to the law, and work to have visitors adhere to the law.

There are discussions underway with Shearon to develop plans for plantings at the entrances and other common areas that will strive to reduce our costs and keep the community beautiful. We will be looking for community participation for this activity. Other activities are being planned where we will look for community participation to improve our community curb appeal. More to come. Hoping for a mild rest of the winter.
