Cricket Themed Exercise Books

- They appear to be issued between 1930 and 1936-7
- Mostly show photographs of Australian and English players in Ashes series
- Probably one of the least documented or recorded cricket cartophilic items
- They were sold Australia wide often their promotion was lined up with the back to school sales
- The books are generally not branded so the issuer is anonymous


