FERNS

Tassel Fern, Polystichum polyblepharum





Height: 18-24 inches evergreen perennial (space 24 inches apart for full ground cover)

Dark green, glossy foliage with fuzzy bronze stems

Plant in well-drained soil, part to full shade

Heat and drought tolerant, keep well-watered until established

Deer resistant

PERENNIALS

Beard tongue, Penstemon digitalis 'Huskers Red'





Height: 2-3 feet tall, up to 2 feet wide semi-evergreen perennial

Plant in well-drained soil in full sun, do not over-fertilize

Blooms late spring through early summer

Color: white tubular flowers on tall stems, with dark maroon-red leaves and stems

The foliage is maroon in spring, turning greener with age but with maroon veining. The stems remain red making a nice contrast.

'Huskers Red' is drought tolerant once established. Wet winter soils will cause root rot

Attracts bees and hummingbirds

Bee balm, Monarda Sugar Buzz 'Bubblegum Blast'





Height: up to 2 feet tall and wide perennial - dwarf

Plant in full sun to partial sun

Blooms July through August (deadhead to prolong bloom)

Color: bubblegum pink flowers on aromatic green foliage

In midsummer, this compact form will be covered with bubblegum pink blooms perched atop upright stems. This disease resistant cultivar is easy to grow, and a beautiful addition to a pollinator-friendly garden. This plant is a butterfly and hummingbird magnet!

Black Eyed Susan, Rudbeckia flugida 'Goldsturm'





Height: 18-24 inches tall and wide perennial

Plant in full sun

Blooms mid-summer through fall

Very attractive to butterflies, and the seed heads provide winter food for songbirds

Easy to maintain, it is unbothered by insects or drought, will tolerate clay soils

'Goldsturm' is a true perennial variety, getting bigger and better each year

Height: 9-12 inches tall and wide perennial

Plant in full sun, in well drained soil

Blooms late spring through fall

Color: rusty-red daisies with yellow tips with a chocolate center

Flowers are a favorite of bees and butterflies, and goldfinches adore the seed heads

A good cut flower for fresh or dried arrangements

Deadhead to encourage reblooming

Deer resistant, drought tolerant

Blazing star, Liatris spicata 'Kobold'





Height: 2-3 feet tall, 1-2 feet wide perennial

Plant in well-drained soil in full sun

Blooms late summer from July through September

Color: bright purple flower plumes

'Kobold' is a compact variety, with each large feathery-looking, bright purple flower plume growing up to 36 inches tall. Due to its small size, this plant requires less staking as its sturdy stems can properly handle the weight of their large flowers.

Flowers are useful as fresh cut or dried

Height: 2-3 feet tall and wide perennial

Plant in full sun to part shade Blooms through late spring

Color: powder blue 1/2" star-like flowers appear in clusters atop stems rising to 3 feet tall

Feathery green summer foliage with a bright golden fall color

Beautiful planted in masses

Attracts butterflies

Deer tolerant

Native to the central Arkansas mountains

Catmint, Nepeta racemosa 'Walker's Low'





Height: 2-3 feet tall and wide perennial

Plant in well-drained soil in full sun to partial sun, do not overwater

Blooms from spring to fall

Color: pale blue to deep violet small trumpet-shaped flower clusters and gray-green aromatic foliage

Thrives in dry soils and is very tolerant of drought. Somewhat intolerant of the heat and humidity of the southeast, however, and appreciates some light afternoon shade in hot summer climates.

Shear flower spikes after initial flowering to promote continued bloom.

Coneflower, Echinacea purpurea 'Pollynation Yellow'





Height: 24 inches tall and wide perennial Plant in full sun, in well drained soil

Blooms early summer to fall

Color: butter yellow, with a prominent darker yellow/green cone

Beautiful daisy shaped flower with fully double petals

Deadhead to prolong bloom period

Attracts bees and butterflies

Excellent heat and drought tolerance

Plant in well-drained soil in full to partial sun

Blooms in late spring to early summer, followed by eye-catching seed pods

Has a full and bushy habit, a perfect substitute for shrubs.

Can be used as a specimen plant, or in back of the border.

Baptisia is easy to grow and will thrive with little maintenance.

Plants are very long-lived once established.

Joe Pye weed, Eupatorium purpureum 'Euphoria Ruby'





Height: 2-3 feet tall and wide, native hybrid perennial Plant in full sun to partial sun, in well drained moist soil

Blooms from early summer well into fall

Color: magenta purple-pink flowers on tall, sturdy, reddish-purple stems.

This is a compact, early-flowering variety of our much larger classic summer flowering native perennial.

Great used as an accent, in a mass, native plant garden, rain garden, foundation planting, or cottage garden.

Cut back in fall or early spring to encourage healthy new growth the next season.

Attracts bees, butterflies and other pollinators

Lantana camara 'Pink Huff'





Height: 16-18" tall and 24-36" wide mounding perennial

Plant in well drained soil with at least 6 hours of full sun per day

Blooms from early summer to frost

Color: clusters of pink and yellow flowers attract butterflies and other pollinators

This is one of the hardiest Lantanas for our area

Cut back by 1/3 to 1/2 in early to midsummer and fertilize if flowering slows

Wait until new growth begins again in spring to cut back after winter to protect the crown

Mulch over winter will help ensure winter survival

Deer resistant, drought tolerant, generally pest free

Lavender, Lavandula x intermedia 'Phenomenal'





Height: 3 feet tall and wide, evergreen perennial

Plant in full sun in VERY well-draining soil with neutral pH (mix soil with small gravel, on a slight mound), and do not fertilize or overwater

Blooms in mid-summer until fall

Color: fragrant lavender flower spikes in summer, with fragrant gray-green foliage

This is one of the newest and most versatile lavenders, capable of thriving in dry, hot and cold climates, and notable for tolerating our southern humidity.

Lavender 'Phenomenal' fragrance is strongest and the flowering is most spectacular in the hottest and driest summers, and when the lavender is planted in nutrient poor soils.

'Phenomenal' can live up to 15 years with the proper care. Deadhead regularly to extend the flowering time.

Prune annually in late fall by no more than 1/3, removing flower spikes and shaping into a mound.

Plant each lavender 3 feet apart, or every 2 feet for full hedges.

Drought resistant, heat tolerant, tolerates some humidity, cold hardy, and tolerates freezing winter temperatures.

Rose Mallow, Hibiscus 'Midnight Marvel'





Height: 4-5 feet tall and wide perennial

Plant in well-drained moist acidic soil in full sun

Blooms from mid-summer through fall

Color: deep scarlet red flowers 8-9 inches across, with nearly black foliage

These North American native hybrids provide massive, tropical-looking flowers and a striking focal point to your late summer and fall garden.

Although later to emerge than most perennials in spring, these are fast growing plants capable of adding an inch of new growth a day.

Requires very little care, has a natural compact rounded shape without pruning

'Carolina Sapphire' Cypress, Cupressus





Height: 40-50 feet tall, 15-20 feet wide evergreen landscape tree

Plant in full sun to part sun

Used for a screening or specimen tree

Great tree for privacy screen or wind barrier, plant at least 7 feet apart. Beautiful silvery blue coloration year round. Branches are sturdy, but have a lacy appearance. Its aroma and color make it wonderful for use as holiday greenery.

Grows fast at 1-3 feet per year

Good choice for a windbreak or erosion control on hillsides

Height: 6-9 feet flowering deciduous shrub

Plant in full sun to partial shade Blooms late winter to early spring

Color: brilliant golden flowers emerge before leaves

Harbinger of spring, flowers on arching branches brighten the landscape when very little is in bloom

Does not require pruning, but benefits from it periodically to rejuvenate the plant

Cut long branches in bud stage for forcing into flower inside in late winter

Height: 3-4 feet tall, 5-6 feet wide evergreen shrub

Plant in full to part sun in well-drained soil

Blooms in spring through summer

Most tolerant of all gardenias to frost

Also tolerates heat and humidity

Blooms late winter through early spring, followed by large palmate leaves

Prefers moist, well-drained soil and regular watering first year

Beneficial nectar for early pollinators Bark was once used to make paper

Height: 3-4 feet tall, 5-6 feet wide deciduous shrub

Plant in full sun to partial shade

Blooms very early spring, beneficial for early pollinators

Edible small yellow fruit attracts birds and wildlife, also makes a tasty preserve or jelly

Height: 10-12 feet tall, 6-8 feet wide evergreen shrub Plant in partial sun to shade, prefers afternoon shade

Blooms in spring and sporadically through fall

Color: tiny creamy flowers have a powerful apricot or jasmine-like fragrance that drifts through the garden

Not fussy about soil, even tolerates heavy clay

Can train as a small tree

Wonderful groundcover for between stones in paths or as erosion control on slopes

Blooms attract butterflies and hummingbirds

Spreads very slowly by rhizomes

Color: bright green and gold grasslike, narrow blades

Color: flower plumes in pink to pinkish red

It is the fall flowering that most distinguishes this native grass.
