


	<p>Wood's Light Blue Aster</p> <p><i>Aster dumosus 'Wood's Light Blue'</i></p>	<p>Height: 8-12 inches Bloom time: September-October Color: light-blue Grow in full sun Attracts hummingbirds and butterflies. Deer resistant Native</p>
	<p>Miss Huff Lantana</p> <p><i>Lantana 'Miss Huff'</i></p>	<p>Height: 4-5 feet--a small shrub Grow in full sun; tolerates some shade Blooms from early summer until frost Color: orange/yellow Attracts hummingbirds and butterflies Deer resistant Drought tolerant Most cold hardy of all lantanas: will die to ground locally but if left un-pruned and mulched, will come back from roots. First discovered growing in Miss Ruby Huff's yard in Athens, GA.</p>
	<p>Cardinal Flower— Red</p> <p><i>Lobelia cardinalis</i></p>	<p>Height: 2-4 feet Grow in full sun to part shade Blooms summer Color: red Attracts hummingbirds and butterflies Deer resistant Needs very moist soil or wetlands Native</p>
	<p>Ultra Violet Sage</p> <p><i>Salvia 'Ultra Violet'</i></p>	<p>Height: 18-20 inches Grows in full sun Blooms July to frost Color: pink Most cold-hardy Salvia (zone 5b) Developed by a hummingbird-initiated cross between a blue and a pink Salvia Drought tolerant Native</p>



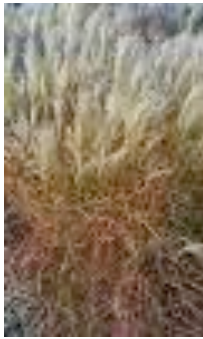
Autumn Fern  
*Dryopteris erythrosora*

Height: 18 inches.  
Spacing: 18 inches for full ground cover  
Grow in part to full shade.  
Fronds change color from copper-red to bronze to green.  
Heat tolerant.  
Keep well watered until established.  
Usually semi-evergreen in winter.



Coral Bells  
*Heuchera*  
'Plum Pudding'

Height: 15 inches  
Grown for foliage--has small flowers  
Color: plum  
Plant in part shade  
Thrives with summer heat & humidity  
Once established will grow in dry shade  
Attracts hummingbirds  
Rarely bothered by deer



Maiden Grass (Eulalia)  
*Miscanthus*  
*purpurascens*

An ornamental grass  
Height: 4-5 ft.  
Grow in full sun to part shade  
Blooms July to February  
Color: red-tinged  
Provides winter interest  
Attracts birds  
Tolerates drought



Montbretia--Yellow  
*Crocosmia* 'Norwich  
'Canary'

Height: 24-30 inches  
Bloom time: mid-summer  
Color: gold to orange  
Plant in full sun  
Attracts hummingbirds  
Plant in well-drained soil



Lenten Rose--Red Lady  
*Heleborus hybridus*  
'Red Lady'

Height: 12-18 in. tall.  
Bloom time: February-April  
Color: red  
Plant in part shade to full shade.  
Keep out of hot summer sun.  
Leaves: Evergreen  
Deer resistant



Plantain Lily  
*Hosta 'June'*

Height: 12 inches; Bloom stalk: 20 inches  
Shade-loving  
Blooms in summer  
Color: purple  
Needs moist soil  
Frequently eaten by deer



Garden Phlox--white  
*Phlox paniculata 'David'*

Height: 2-4 feet  
Grow in full sun to part shade  
Blooms July-September  
Color: white  
Attracts hummingbirds and butterflies  
Deer resistant



Japanese Painted Fern  
*Athyrum niponicum*  
*"Pietum"*

Height: 18 inches  
Spacing: 18 inches for full ground cover  
Grow in part to full shade.  
Best frond color in light shade  
Weeping habit  
Dies back in winter



Azalea, Evergreen--  
Dark Pink  
*Azalea Girard 'Rose'*






Height: 2-4 feet  
Grow in part shade  
Blooms in mid-spring  
Color: rose  
Needs regular watering  
Semi-evergreen











Butterfly Bush--  
purple  
*Buddleia*  
*'Nanho Purple'*

Height 3-5 feet  
Grow in full sun  
Blooms June-September  
Attracts hummingbirds and butterflies  
Deer resistant  
Drought tolerant



	<p>Camellia Japonica</p> <p><i>Camellia Japonica</i> <i>'Professor Sargent'</i></p>	<p>Height: 6-8 feet  Grow in partial shade--no direct sun after noon-time  Blooms mid-winter to spring  Color: red, double bloom  Evergreen</p>
	<p>Gardenia--White</p> <p><i>'Frostproof'</i></p>	<p>Height: 5 feet  Plant in full sun to partial shade (in p.m.)  Upright growth habit  Blooms in spring to early summer with 2-3 inch flowers.  Water regularly until established.  Evergreen  Deer resistant</p>
	<p>Hydrangea</p> <p><i>'Vanilla Strawberry'</i></p>	<p>Height: 6-7 feet  Plant in partial shade  Form of Pee Gee Hydrangea  Blooms July-September  Color: each bloom goes from green to white to pink  Needs regular watering  Attracts butterflies</p>
	<p>Virginia Sweetspire</p> <p><i>Itea virginica 'Henry's Garnet'</i></p>	<p>Height: 3-4 feet  Plant in full sun to part shade, but tolerates heavy shade  Blooms May-June  Color: white  Needs regular watering--perhaps plant in rain garden</p>
	<p>Mountain Laurel</p> <p><i>Kalmia 'Carousel'</i></p>	<p>Height: 6-10 feet  Plant in shade  Blooms in spring  Color: white with lavender, cinnamon, purplish bands  Drought tolerant  Attracts birds  Deer resistant  Native</p>

	<p>Dog Hobble</p> <p>Leucothoe axillaris 'Jenkins'</p>	<p>Height: 3-4 feet Plant in shade Blooms in spring Color: white Evergreen broad leaves Hybrid-native Growth said to "hobble" dogs who attempt to run through bush</p>
	<p>Native Azalea-- Yellow</p> <p><i>Rhododendron</i> <i>"Admiral Semmes"</i></p>	<p>Height: 6-12 feet Flowers in May Color: yellow Fragrant Attracts butterflies Hybrid-native</p>
	<p>Rhododendron-- Lavender</p> <p><i>Rhododendron</i> <i>'Catawbiense</i> <i>Grandiflorum'</i></p>	<p>Height: 6-8 feet Plant in full sun to partial shade Flowers in May Color: lavender Deer resistant Keep evenly moist with no standing water Hybrid-native</p>
	<p>Rosy Pink Native Azalea</p> <p><i>Rhododendron</i> <i>periclymenoides</i> <i>'Rosy Pink Nudiflorum'</i></p>	<p>Height: 6-8 feet Plant in partial shade Flowers in April before leaves open Color: pink Attracts hummingbirds and butterflies. Deciduous Native</p>
	<p>Blueberry--Southern, Compact</p> <p><i>Vaccinium</i> <i>'Sunshine</i> <i>Blue'</i></p>	<p>Height: 3 feet Plant in full sun to partial shade Flowers in May in a light pink color Berries ripen in June Self-fertile Good leaf color in fall Attracts birds (to eat berries) Use: ornamental shrub (can be container-grown)</p>

	<p>Chinese Snowball Viburnum</p> <p>Viburnum macrocephalum 'Snowball'</p>	<p>Height: 10-15 feet Plant in full sun to light shade Flowers in April-May Color: white--size of a softball Attracts butterflies</p>
	<p>Brown Turkey Fig</p> <p>Ficus carica 'Brown Turkey'</p>	<p>Height: 15-25 feet Plant in full sun to light shade Flowers are insignificant Birds are attracted to fruit Deer resistant Needs regular watering for first year</p>
	<p>Blackberry--Thornless</p> <p><i>Rubus 'Arapaho thornless'</i></p>	<p>Grow in full sun. Canes stand erect and are thornless. Berries ripen in 4 weeks--in early June Produces sucker plants to quickly establish hedge row of plants Songbirds and butterflies eat berries</p>
	<p>Raspberries</p> <p>Rubus idaeus 'Heritage'</p>	<p>Plant in full/part sun Height: 5-6 ft. tall "Everbearing" with moderate crop in July and heavy crop in September Requires no staking Attracts birds and butterflies Showy flowers</p>
	<p>Rabbiteye blueberries <i>Vaccinium</i></p> <p>NOTE: One of the most important growing requirements of rabbiteye blueberries is their need for cross-pollination in order to set fruit. You will need to plant more than one variety for cross-pollination to occur</p>	<p>'Powderblue' &amp; 'Tifblue'</p> <p>Plant in full sun Size: about 8 feet by 8 feet Needs moist, well-drained, acid soil Good landscape shrub Produces fall color in leaves June to August berry production.</p>
