Gombolola Cup / Ekikopo ky'amaggombolola (Football, Netball, Mweso)

19th January - 30th March

Played at Ssaza (County) level as one of the build-up activities to Kabaka's birthday celebrations, the competition is broken down into 18 mini tournaments organized by and named after the official title of each Ssaza Chief, e.g Pookino Cup in Buddu.

The event attracts a maximum of 175 Ggombolola (Sub - Counties) teams. The 2025 Calendar includes Football, Netball and Mweso with estimated 56 direct participants per Ggombolola, totalling to 4,375 football players, 1050 Mweso players, 2,625 Netball players and 1,750 team officials.

As a starter event for the Sports Calendar, Ggombolola Cup is a direct feeder for both the Bika and Masaza Competitions and works as a mass mobilization tool for all activities within Buganda, since it rallies everyone at the Sub-County level to engage from the beginning of the year, offering an impact base at the grass-root estimated at 3 million people.

Information collected from here creates the basic database for registration for the other events. 18 trophies awarded at Ssaza level.

Ng'omuzannyo oguggulawo kalenda y'omwaka, ekikopo kino kiriikiriza buterevu empaka z'Ebika n'omupiira gw'Amasaza era zikozesebwa mu kuyambako okukuunga abantu ba Buganda okwenyigira mu nteekateeka z'Obwakabaka olw'esonga nti abantu bonna benyigiramu buterevu okusinziira mu Ggombolola gyebasibuka ku ntandikwa y'omwaka era kino kinyweza obumu mu bantu n'okukolera awamu nga abantu abasuubira okwenyigiramu bawerera ddala obukadde 3.

The Buganda Sports Awards Gala/luncheon

Tuesday 4th February
Butikkiro

The event, hosted by the Katikkiro, is organised to celebrate outstanding persons in the sports Calendar of the ending year 2024.

Buganda Schools Gala / Empaka z'amasomero

Thursday 13th – Sunday 16th March

Played as a 3 to 5-day gala for both primary and secondary schools, the multi-sport tournament brings together players in schools geographically located within the Buganda Region and aims at offering pre-season preparation and testing to these schools ahead of the national schools' Calendar.

Participation in 2025 is based on early registration and confirmation of fees, plus regional representation. The events shall include Football, Volleyball, Basketball, Handball, in both genders, while is Netball for girls only and Mweso for Boys only.

The event attracts a maximum of 32 teams per gender per sport with up to 4,128 players for Secondary Schools (Kabaka Cup) and 2,064 for primary schools (Nabagereka Cup).

Empaka zeta bwamu ttiimu ezitakka wansi wa 32 mu bawala n'abalenzi mu buli muzannyo okukola omugatte gw'abazannyi 4,128 ku mutendera gwa Secondary (Kabaka Cup) wamu n'abazannyi 2,064 ku mutendera gwa Primary (Nabagereka Cup).

Kabaka's Birthday Run / Emisinde gy'Amazaalibwa ga Ssaabasajja Kabaka

Sunday 6th April

Organised annually as a fan run, this is arguably the largest of such events in Africa, attracting over 110,000 participants to celebrate the Birthday of the Kabaka and respond to his call of Fighting HIV/AIDS.

The event is run in 3 distance categories of 5km, 10km & 21km, where entrance is tagged on purchase of the running kit.

While the main event starts at the Lubiri palace, mini events are organized across the whole Kingdom and in the Diaspora for those who cannot make it to the main event.

Buganda Cycling Tours

Conducted on a system of tours, where riders from various counties and groups compete to collect points over the different races, the event aims at using cycling as a tool for social change, promotion of environment friendly activities, and unity through exploring Buganda Kingdom.

Each year, different Counties (Masaza) are given an opportunity to host a tour, complete with awards and gifts, in categories of road and ordinary bikes, for both men and women, with a capacity of 432 riders per race and over 3000 fans along the routes covering up to 120Km.

The 1st tour is aligned to Kabaka's birthday celebration, the 2nd to coronation celebrations and the last tour of the year held as part of the celebrations for the Buganda Youth Day, after which results from all individual races are compiled to determine the overall winners of the year.

Buli mwaka amasaza ag'enjawulo gaweewwa omukisa okukyaza empaka zino era ebirabo biweebwa abawanguzi mu miteeko egy'enjawulo, mu mutendera gw'gaali enzungu wamy ne mannyi ga kiffuba mu bawala n'abalenzi. Abavuzi 432 bebakirizibwa mu buli luvuga era abawagizi ababeera ku nguudo nga balindiridde basukka mu 3000 mu lugendo oluweza 120km.

Bika Sports programs is aimed at encouraging pride in the foundational structuring of the people of Uganda and Buganda, identified by their basic cultural grouping of a Clan, under the tribe of a Muganda. The appreciation of one's cultural fabric and heritage aids one's understanding of the intrinsic structuring of Uganda, hence promoting unity in a diverse nation.

The 2025 season starts with a dinner where Clan heads host their clan members to an official get together.

This shall be followed by the Netball Gala, played in one week and thereafter the football competition, whose opening ceremony serves as the closing ceremony for Netball.

This year's program has been enhanced with the introduction of a 2-day kids holiday gala for children 12 years old and below, where parents shall be the ones to directly register their children in selected events including mind sports, racket games and others. Fun sport through night futsal has also been considered where individual football lovers (30 years and above) register to play under their clans.

The events attract a maximum 56 clans translating into 1400 football players, 840 netball players and over 600 direct team officials.

Omwaka 2025 gutandika n'ekijjulo ng'Abataka abakulu ab'Obusolya bakyaza Bazzukulu baabwe ku kijjulo ekitongole; olwo, empaka z'okubaka zizannyibwe mu bbanga lya wiiki emu era zikomekerezebwe ku lunaku olugulawo omupiira ogw'ebigere. Empaka zeetabwamu ebika ebitakka wansi wa 56 nga bikola abazannyi b'omupiira ogw'ebigere 1400, abazannyi b'omupiira ogw'okubaka 840 n'abakulembeze ba ttiimu 600.

Masaza Football Cup

Launch Wednesday 2nd July
Opening Saturday 5th July
Closing Saturday 1st November

The Kingdom's premium sporting event brings together 18 teams representing all the Masaza (Counties) of Buganda and is played on a home and away basis in group stages, before teams proceed to the knock-out stages, up to the finals.

With a money economy currently at about 7 billion, Masaza Cup is the epitome of pride, loyalty and football talent development in Uganda, where only about 450 players (who don't play in the top 2 tiers of the national league) get a chance to play for one of the counties in an event that attracts over 320,000 fans across the 104 games played in a four months period and fills up any local stadium with ease, promoting unity among-st all people leaving in the geographical location of Buganda, while giving football lovers across the nation a unique event and experience of culture, modernity and sport worth being part of, with an estimated media reach of over 8 million people.

Abawagizi abasuka mu 320,000 balaba emipiira 104 egizannyibwa mu bbanga lya myezi 4 nga kino kinyweeza obumu mu bantu ba Buganda abawangaalira mu bitundu empaka zino gyezizannyirwa era zisikiriza banna mupiira okwetoolola eggwanga.
