The Sub-Plot

Involves strictly or mainly Israel, i.e., Jews

Abrahamic Covenant

1. God will make Israel the greatest nation in history.

2. God will bless Abraham with eternal life.

3. God will grant eternal life to all those who demonstrate the same kind of belief as Abraham.

The Main Plot

Involves both Israel, i.e., Jews, and Gentiles

Mosaic Covenant

1. By obeying the Mosaic Covenant, Israel fulfills God's condition for becoming the greatest nation in history.

2. The Jews properly demonstrate God's character to the Gentiles, thus attracting them to Him.

3. The Mosaic Covenant predicts an ultimate and final leader of the Jews.

Jesus is the final leader of both Jews and Gentiles

4. God threatens the Jews with expulsion from the land for their disobedience.

5. God promises inward obedience to the Jews and to fulfill the Abrahamic promise of their greatness.

Davidic Covenant

1. David will be great because his descendant will be the King of the Jews.

Jesus is King of both Jews and Gentiles

2. The Jews will live safely and securely on their land.

3. David's descendants will be God's Son, continuing forever.

Jesus is the eternal Son of God for both Jews and Gentiles

4. Solomon will build a temple for God.

5. David's kingdom will last forever.

Jesus' kingdom of both Jews and Gentiles lasts forever

New Covenant

1. God repeats that He will change the hearts of all living Jews.

On the basis of His predestination God changes the hearts of all Jews and Gentiles He has chosen

2. God will forgive the sins of all living Jews

On the basis of Jesus' death God forgives the sins of all Jews and Gentiles He has chosen
