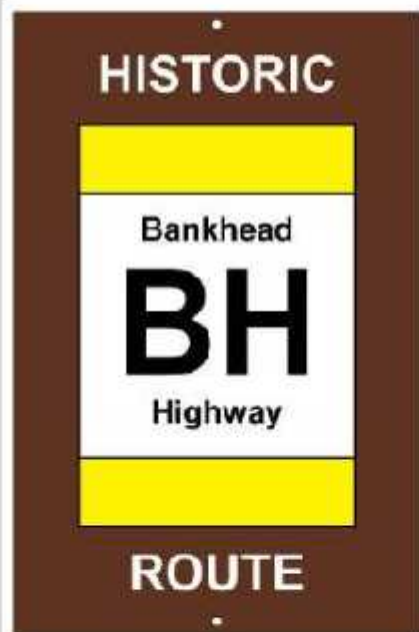

2016 marks the 100th anniversary of John Hollis Bankhead's Federal Aid Highway Act of 1916, which helped fund Asa Roundtree's dream of a transcontinental highway across the South. With funding now shared by states and the federal government, the Bankhead became the nation's first all-weather, all-season, coast-to-coast highway connecting Washington D.C. with San Diego, CA.

A commemorative four day Texas BH Tour will begin in Texarkana and end in Odessa. You are invited to travel all or any portion of the route.
