Tale of The Trojans

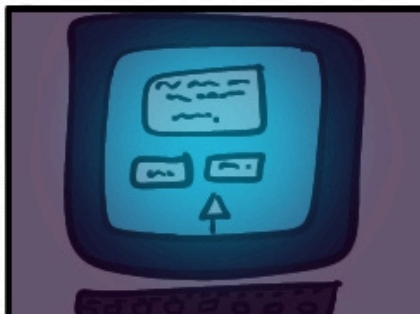


S: THAT DOESNT SOL-

S: For example,

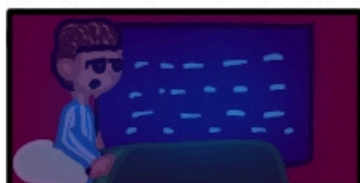
