### Target Audience:

### Setup Needed:

Projector & Microphone

### Duration:

60-80 minutes

### Event Title:

“Protecting Your Digital Future”

### Event Objectives:

By the end of the presentation, students will:

1. *Understand the importance of cybersecurity in their daily lives.*
2. *Recognize the potential risks of their online actions.*
3. *Learn practical steps to stay safe and secure online.*

### Event Structure:

1. **Welcome and Introduction**
  - Principal's Opening Remarks
2. **Keynote Presentation**
  - Speaker: Cybersecurity Expert
  - Content:
    - i. The basics of cybersecurity (e.g., digital footprints, phishing, secure passwords).
    - ii. Real-life stories or case studies about online safety and risks
    - iii. Visuals (statistics, images, videos)
    - iv. Practical tips for staying secure online
3. **Live Demonstration**
  - Activity: Password Cracker (\*Preselected common sample passwords\*)
  - Needed: 1-2 Student Volunteers
4. **Interactive Game**
  - Activity: Spot the Scam!
  - Needed: Students/Teachers volunteer on stage
  - Prizes: TBD
5. **Closing Remarks / Final Words**
  - Key Message Reminder
  - Call to Action
