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SAFETY SCENARIOS!

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SCENARIO 1

A student asks an AI chatbot to explain math concepts and help them understand how to solve problems.

SAFE, **THINK AGAIN**, or **NOT SAFE**?

SCENARIO 2

A student talks to an AI chatbot about family problems because it feels easier than talking to a real person.

SAFE, **THINK AGAIN**, or **NOT SAFE**?





THINK AGAIN



AI may seem comforting, but trusted adults are better equipped to provide emotional support and help.





SCENARIO 3

A video shows a celebrity (or student) saying something shocking, but it might not be real.

SAFE, **THINK AGAIN**, or **NOT SAFE**?





NOT SAFE X

AI-generated fake videos can spread misinformation and should always be checked with trusted sources.



SCENARIO 4



Someone in an online game says they are your age and asks to message you privately.

SAFE, **THINK AGAIN**, or **NOT SAFE**?





NOT SAFE X

People online may pretend to be
someone they are not!





SCENARIO 5

A student submits a homework assignment written fully by AI without doing any of the work themselves.

SAFE, **THINK AGAIN**, or **NOT SAFE**?





NOT SAFE X

Letting AI do all the work stops you from learning and can lead to academic consequences.
