

Sample Presentation Outline (Small Group)

Target Audience:

Ideally for Elementary/Middle School

Setup Needed:

Projector

Whiteboards/Markers OR Paper/Pencil

Duration:

45 minutes

Event Title:

“Protecting Your Digital Future”

Event Objectives:

By the end of the presentation, students will:

1. *Define key terms related to cybersecurity (e.g., phishing, digital footprint).*
2. *Identify at least three ways to protect themselves online.*
3. *Recognize how their actions can have long-term impacts*

Event Structure:

1. **Introduction**
 - Welcome
 - Icebreaker Activity: “What Are Things You Do Online Everyday”
2. **Presentation**
 - Engaging visuals on key cybersecurity concepts/definitions (slides)
 - Real-world, relate scenarios students may find themselves in
3. **Group Activity: Scenario Showdown**
 - Students split into small groups
 - Each group provided with a scenario
 - Each group devises a plan on how they’d respond safely
4. **Wrap Up Discussion / Closing Remarks**
 - Key Message Reminder
 - Call to Action

2. *Informational Sheet/Pamphlets/Stickers*
