

LAKE COUNTRY GRANTS APPLICATION OVERVIEW & GUIDELINES

SECTION 1:

What type of projects will LCAC provide funding? This list is not exhaustive it provides examples but is not limited to:

*Music Events

*Music Festivals

*Live Theatre

*Dance

*Stand-Up Comedy

*Spoken Word

*Arts/Children's Festivals

*Visual Arts

Preference will be given to projects that include:

Diverse visual and performing arts activities and events.

Opportunities for local artists (residents of Lake Country) to showcase their art forms through performance, exhibits, creation and appreciation of their art.

Activities that provide opportunities for Lake Country residents to explore and develop their artistic selves (all life stages children-adulthood).

Arts education projects.

Community engagement that involves the arts.

Needs assessment of Lake Country's art needs.

SECTION 2:

The funding year for LCAC runs until December 31st, 2019. Funding may close early if all funds have been allocated for the year.

LCAC funding will be granted for the purpose of the direct delivery of arts-based activities as defined by Section 1.

The event must be non-sectarian.

You may apply for a single project or multi-year. The project must be upcoming. No retroactive activities will be accepted.



A maximum of \$1200 per single event/year, seed funding and one-off projects are accepted. In future years all returning applicants funded will receive 50% of the initial previous year's approval.

Funding is available for the same single project once every 3 years. Multi-year projects for up to 3 years maximum, an organization can apply twice in a 10 year period for multi-year projects (this will be based on the first year of the first approved project.)
