RULE #1

When Y comes at the end of a word, Y is a vowel.

RULE #2

When Y is the only vowel at the end of a one syllable word, Y has the sound of long I.

RULE #3

When Y is the only vowel at the end of a word of more than one syllable, Y has the sound of long E.
