


## BISHOPS ANNUAL APPEAL



Biography of Fr. Neal Nichols



Fr. Nichols is a native of Richmond where he grew up, attended St. Benedict's parochial school and graduated from Benedictine High School in 1979 and Hampden-Sydney College in 1983.

After working in the family business for 11 years, he entered Our Lady of Guadalupe Seminary in 1994 and was ordained a priest of the Priestly Fraternity of St. Peter in 2001-a priestly order of apostolic life founded by the authority of St. Pope John Paul II. Father was transferred to Chesapeake in 2008 to administer St. Benedict's Chapel which was later elevated to a parish in 2012, thus becoming its first pastor.
