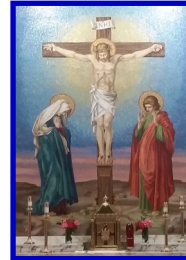
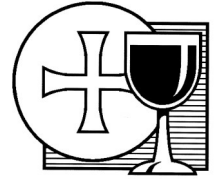

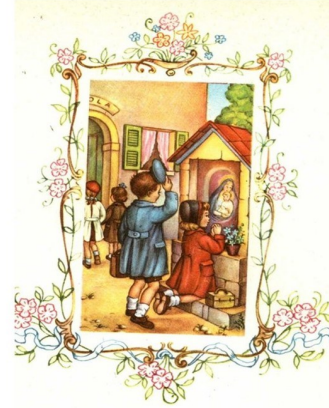
Synod on Synodality Q&A

What you need to know about St. Mary's Synodality (Sin-odd-al-a-tee) Initiative

- 1. What is it?** A program similar to other past evangelical programs but different too. Called for by the Pope, based on Vatican II insights and values, it is designed to refresh our Church. Synod means, literally, walking together, and to start, the Richmond diocese has provided support and encouragement: participant guides, questions, etc.
- 2. How different?** This has been envisioned as an ongoing process, in phases, rather than a limited-time process formed primarily to produce a document or stimulate the Church. Phase One, to be concluded in early March 2022, will produce ideas to be forwarded to Richmond and eventually to Rome for a Church-wide Synod of Church leaders in 2023.
- 3. More particulars?** It will help the Church to grow with the emphasis on bottom-up, rather than top-down. Small groups will be formed to gather insights and hopes from not just the regular dedicated people of our parishioner, but also from those whose voices are rarely heard, and even from some outside our Church, of other faith communities.
- 4. When will this happen?** The initial roll-out is scheduled for the weekend of January 29/30, with brief announcements and sign-ups starting then, but with sign-ups also on February 5/6.
- 5. Choose your sessions:** Those who sign up may choose between a single hour-and-a-half session of limited involvement with a facilitator and questions prepared for them ahead of the group, or a more thorough involvement of three sessions, with the idea of being able to deal with the many questions with more depth and time to build on initial sessions.
- 6. Weekend and Weekday Sessions:** Once groups have been formed based on the sign-ups, with multi-session weekday groups meeting initially on ***Tuesday morning 2/15 after the 10am mass*** or ***2/16 Wednesday night at 6:30***. The first weekend single session group will meet on ***Saturday 2/26 at 3:00*** leading to 5:00 mass, and a single session weekday group meeting ***Thursday 3/13 at 6:30pm***.
