

Saints of the Week




St. Columban, Abbot

St. Columbanus is one of the most famous Irishmen in history. As a young man, he was a rigorous and ascetic monk. At age 50, he became a missionary, and with twelve companions spread the Gospel through much of western Europe. His monastic Rule became a model for future generations.

St. Catherine of Alexandria

Fifty pagan philosophers are said to have debated with St. Catherine, hoping to convince her to abjure her faith. Instead, Catherine converted them to Christianity. Furious, the Emperor ordered her to be put to death on a spiked wheel; but the wheel broke. Eventually, she was martyred by beheading.





St. Siricius, Pope

When Siricius became Pope in 384, he immediately established a good relationship with St. Ambrose of Milan. He was moderate and balanced in his administration of the Church; and historically is one of the first Popes we see exercising the papal primacy.

St. James of the Marches, Franciscan

St. James, known from his birthplace as "of the Marches" became a Franciscan in 1415. Much of his career was spent as a papal envoy in eastern Europe. He was a noted preacher, fiery, but with a severity tempered by mercy. To fight against usury, he established lending houses to assist the poor.



St. Saturnin, Martyr on the via Salaria nuova

One of countless martyrs during the early centuries of Christianity, St. Saturninus was originally from Carthage. An inscription by Pope St. Damasus records that, on account of his faith, he was exiled to Rome under the Emperor Decius. He was martyred in 304 by order of the Emperor Maximian.
