

Applicant must have been accepted by an accredited university, college, or trade school as a full-time student prior to scholarship award.

Five hundred dollars (\$500) will be awarded to one graduating senior who is currently registered as a parishioner at St. Mary of the Presentation Catholic Church in Suffolk, Virginia. The scholarship is not renewable and is awarded every year to a different applicant.

The James J. Riley, Sr. Memorial Scholarship honors the memory of Knights of Columbus <u>Suffolk</u> Council 7363 Charter Grand Knight, Jim Riley. 
