

What to expect on that day Originally Posted on June 12, 2014 by Father Lou

I'll let you in on a little secret: I can't wait to die-err, that is, I'll be excited when that inevitable day comes. But I hope I don't hear God calling to me saying, that "Lou, how are you doing?" Isn't our God supposed to know everything? With good and sincere intentions I hear people greet others all the time in supermarkets, in banks, at church, at work, at their kids' little league games with those words "How are you?" But many times it's done perfunctorily, that is, it is what you say to be socialbut the meaning behind it is but superficial-and in fact, natural. But, we don't expect God to be like that. Rather, I want God to greet me saying, "Lou, what a journey you've been on. I was with you all the way. But there are things we ought to talk about."

There's no getting away from that discussion-but my God, I would feel so wonderful—and disarmed and less defensive. And now an even greater fear for me will be after that discussion, if God would say to me, "Come and welcome into the kingdom-but first, spend some time with some other guests at our cocktail lounge." Cocktail lounge? Gosh, talk about superficial! I have a hard time at those things. I like serious talk, honest talk, real talk with real people. And then, I start to think, "well there's no time in the Kingdom; this can go on forever-and that could be hell!" O God, I love talking to you everydayand more so seeing you as you are. Being invited to your Kingdom would be heaven to meand though I don't deserve it, I am honored to be in your presence
