

Synod

An ancient and venerable Greek word "to walk together" is a gathering of bishops called by the Holy Father to reflect and to offer counsel on important pastoral matters in the life of the church. The 2021-2023 Synod will be on the subject of " For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation, and Mission."

Why Synodality?

A Synodality enables the entire People of God to walk forward together, listening to the Holy Spirit and the Word of God, to participate in the mission of the Church in the communion that Christ establishes between us.

The entire People of God shares a common dignity and vocation through Baptism. All of us are called in virtue of our Baptism to be active participants in the life of the church.

A true Synodal process is listening, discernment and participation.
