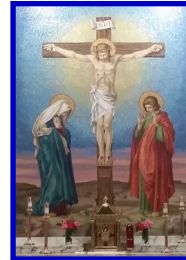

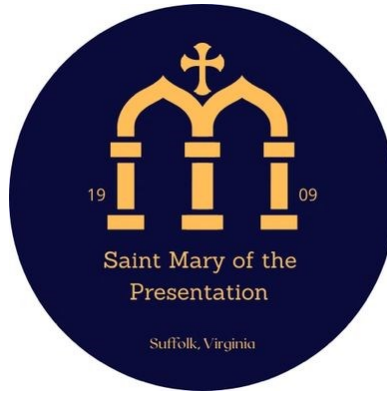

Amount: \$500 (non-renewable; fall semester tuition; amount may increase after donations from club members are accounted for)

Required criteria:

1. Member of St. Mary of the Presentation Catholic Church
2. Graduating senior who has been accepted into an institution of higher learning
3. Two (2) letters of recommendation (i.e. from church, school, community activities, or work)
4. Essay—200-400 words – "What impact has COVID had on your church life and what opportunity(ies) and/or positive changes has it created?"
5. Transcripts
6. Résumé which may include:
 - Church activities
 - School and extracurricular activities
 - Community Service/Volunteer Activities
 - Leadership activities/skills
 - Awards, honors, and special recognitions
 - Work, hobbies or special interests
7. Application received in the church office by May 1st 2022.

Applications that do not meet the required criteria will not be considered.

Selection will be made by a panel of judges from St. Mary's Women's Club. If there are no qualified applicants in a given year, funds will remain in the St. Mary's Scholarship Fund.

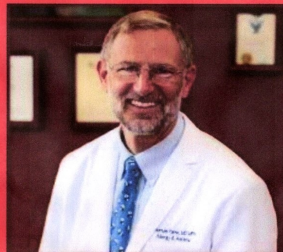
