

The selected individual will work under the supervision of the Pastor and im partnership with the entire parish staff and accountant as a member of the parochial team.



#### Required criteria:

- 3. Two (2) letters of recommendation (i.e. from church, school, community activities, or work)
- 4. Essay-200-400 words -" What impact has COVID had on your church life and what
