Solemnity of the Assumption



CAPS (Coalition Against Poverty in Suffolk) With the blessing of Fr. Emmanuel, and approval of Parish Council, the Outreach Ministry, and the Diocese of Richmond, St. Mary's is now a member of the CAPS Program.

CAPS is a coalition of Christian Churches in the Suffolk Community that work together to help those in crisis. Since CAPS Suffolk began in 2012, several hundred Suffolk families have been served. Those in need submit an application which is reviewed by the CAPS office staff. They assess the situation, provide financial counseling for long-term solutions, as well as prayer support with and for people needing spiritual comfort during their time of distress. CAPS started the Night Stay Program winter shelter and food for those experiencing homelessness during the winter months. **St Mary's Women's Club and the Knights of Columbus have helped with providing dinner in the past.**

As a CAPS member, the church has one voting representative on the Board of Directors. I am serving in that capacity temporarily, but we are in need of someone to take over permanently. Member churches contribute financially to both the Bill assistance Fund and the General Fund (operating expenses including compensation of staff). We encourage churches to re-direct their benevolence funds to the CAPS Bill Assistance pool. We that churches continue providing bill assistance separately to their own congregants of attendees. CAPS ensures the best stewardship of benevolence funds by operating out of single office which frees churches to use their time and talent to serve the poor in different was. CAPS is located in the Workforce Development Build at 157 N. Main St. on the 2nd floor.
