"SO YOU ARE NO LONGER A SLAVE, BUT GOD'S CHILD; AND SINCE YOU ARE HIS CHILD, GOD HAS MADE YOU ALSO AN HEIR." GALATIANS 4:7

Building a solid foundation for your identity starts with knowing and accepting who you are in Christ. Embracing your identity in Christ means letting go of the labels and expectations the world places on you. You no longer find your worth in external factors such as your appearance, accomplishments, or social status. Instead, your worth is rooted in the fact that you are deeply loved and valued by your Heavenly Father.
