



FAIR PROPERTY TAX POLICY

Canton has shifted **\$1.1 BILLION** in taxes from businesses to residents in the last 20 years.

David Clough will apply the **maximum legal tax burden shift** to bring relief back to homeowners.



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PLATFORM

Property Tax Policy

Implement the maximum CIP (commercial, industrial, property) shift allowed by law. Adopt residential and small business exemptions. Failure to apply the full shift over 20 years has moved \$1.1 billion in tax burden onto residents.

Improve the Procurement Process

Create a Department of Public Buildings and hire a municipal Chief of Operations to oversee all major construction and renovation projects.

Introduce Artificial Intelligence to Government

Integrate AI into the town's ERP systems and website to create long-term cost savings that can fund police, fire, school, and union contracts.

Ask the Attorney General to Review the John O'Keefe Case

Request a formal review by the Massachusetts Attorney General and the U.S. Department of Justice.

Restore Trust with the Police

Work with the new Police Chief to develop a strategic plan and rebuild public trust in the department.

Set Spending Limits on Mitigation Funds

Establish limits so mitigation funds cannot be spent without Town Meeting approval.

Require All Committee Meetings Be Televised

Ensure all public meetings are recorded, televised, and archived online to improve transparency.

Hire a Full-Time Grant Specialist

Bring in state and federal funding while reducing the burden on department heads.

Add Bike Lanes on Major Town Roads

Improve safety, reduce emissions, and support MBTA accessibility through bike infrastructure.

Establish a Code of Conduct for Town Officials

Define clear standards of behavior for all elected officials and committee members.

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
