Director's Report - All

- Basketball – Season is over. Championship weekend was a success. Surveys have gone out. Goal is more team parity. Initial travel season a success. Discussion on summer gym time, John will request. Most refs paid via venmo, deemed a success. Tourney coordinator filled. 3 v 3 tournament being planned for July at

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the MYA Building. Hudl usage in Smith and JMUES discussed. \$6k in the black for the year.

- Baseball – Registration has closed, 281 athletes registered. Might be a few stragglers. Will be in the gyms next week. Memorial HR Derby in the works to support a family. Certain age group will play other towns as rec.
- Golf – Registration closed, waitlist only – K-4th program filled with 24 players! 5th-8th grade filled with 23 players. 47 total players. Season starts April 20th (K-4th 1st practice) and April 23rd (5th-8th 1st practice)
- Lacrosse – 222 registered. Indoor practices have begun, outdoor once fields open. Opening day is 4/4. Fiddlesticks in the works.
- Soccer – 560 kids registered so far, Jamboree this summer. New high school coach will be looking to get involved. Playmetrics will not be renewed. Older kids will play in Nashua, lots of kids will play at Elbit. Age group changes policy implemented. To work with Lacrosse for field availability.
- Softball – 9 rec teams and 5 travel teams. Over 100 athletes. Need more fields! 4/12 field day. Parents asking for 4/4 to be off for Easter.
- Football/Cheer – On the Mend looking to build a new tower at Vets. D Mendell will attend town council meeting to discuss the donation. Registration will open on 4/7. Football will take one side of the sign. Partnering with the high school for spring clinic. Sideline only cheer to take place.
- Wrestling – not in attendance

Fields/Facilities Maintenance Needs – Rick Greenier (including email to DPW)

- Baseball – Gibson diamonds to be modified. DPW aware of some issues at BISE. Getinge building will burn!
- Basketball – Courts desired over the summer
- Football/Cheer – Full reconstruction at Vets will not be possible. DPW will fill and seed as best possible. Rick to help get quotes for field reconstruction in Spring 2027.
- Golf – Need Wasserman Mondays and Thursdays through June 15th Mowed lawn when it's time. Reminder for soccer – if the field is being used, might be good to do a once over for stray balls. We do several laps to pick them up, but depending on grass length we hope none are missed. Will reach out to P&R about putting green, may need to meet with town council. Rick to ask trash to be emptied at Wasserman. There is a mice issue.

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- Soccer – Please leave benches at Twardosky. Elbit and Reeds have rodents in the sheds.
- Softball – Raised \$5k for Reeds7 renovation. 4/12 field day, can we have the water turned on? Reeds 1 to be edged by program. Clay requested on the infield. Will need porta potties and trash at Reeds for Tournys on 5/23-5/24, 7/11-7/12 and 7/25 -7/26
