• Football/Cheer –Chandra Miller – Summer conditioning underway at Gibson twice a week. New shed is under construction. About 170 registrants across all programs. Cheer

numbers are down, due to kids going to Hawks. Registration cost was reduced, due to increased fundraising.

• Soccer – Katie Schwartz – Season end 6/22. Equipment drop off scheduled. Tryouts for Fall travel are week of June 17 (moved indoor due to heat), 231 registered (150 male, 81 female). Registration to open for fall July 1 for rec and travel. Fall to begin 9/7 or 9/14. We are a definite no with the suggested fees and schedule from Bud. Working on filling board positions that are going to be open in November (Treasurer, Rec Director and Secretary)

• Baseball - Jason Lancaster - # of participants played in FY24:

FL 2023: 110 Winter 2024: 17 Spring 2024: 276 Summer 2024: 37

Financial status:

Our overall 2024 registration numbers (N=440) were down approximately 15% compared to 2023 (N=509). We did increase our overall sponsorship total in 2024 (\$11,650) compared to 2023 (\$9,225), largely based on uniform/team sponsorships. We also saw a reduction in overall donations (approximately \$5,090 in 2024 vs \$11,000 in 2023). We switched to an online platform for fundraising, instead of printing / distributing physical calendars, which was more convenient, improved cash-handling/security, but we believe led to more of a disconnect with families/players.

Overall, we're in a healthy position and are not at risk of running a deficit but do need to be mindful of expenses and trend our registration and fundraising numbers going forward.

Top issue: Board succession planning. We've identified 3 new board members ahead of fall elections, but expecting a 50% (N=5) departure rate at the end of this year

Top success: For the first time in 4-5 years, we had enough players to field 3 summer/tournament teams (9U, 11U, and 12U).

Director's report: Our season will officially close at the end of next week, with almost all activities ending this weekend. No major on-field issues, no disciplinary actions sent to the board for review/resolution. We will be off all fields as of 6/28, and will need to discuss field access for our fall season (typically starts last week of August and runs through October).

- Basketball Jaymes Larkin Discussion about how to track across sports when coaches are disciplined. 9 new board members voted in on 6/17. Disciplinary policy to be reviewed. Registration will open late Aug/early Sept. 640 in 23-24 season. Might be looking for more gym time in the fall.
- Softball Ryan Flynn Rec season has ended. 10U had successful season. 100% new board this season. Successful fundraising season ~ \$5k. Goal is to host a tournament here in Merrimack in the next few years. 87 players, 2 travel teams. A few out of town players on rosters this year.
