

UPDATES










Throughout January and February, the children in Schoolage 3 room were actively engaged in various activities. We celebrated Lunar New Year by constructing a 3D Lego dragon, creating diamond painting art symbolizing the Year of the Snake, and discussing traditions like sharing red envelopes with classmates. During our open house event, the children took charge as representatives at stations such as science and art. The children also explored Black History month, through storytelling, discussions, and creative activities. The children had the opportunity to reflect on diversity, equality, and the importance of celebrating cultural heritage. As we transition into spring, the children are looking forward to new adventures, outdoor explorations, and fresh learning opportunities.



Like the other rooms our months were filled with self-expression and discovery. One particular activity had some of the children exploring a braille book, became curious about the experience of navigating daily tasks without sight. This led them to challenge themselves by attempting to get dressed while wearing a blindfold, allowing them to better understand what it might feel like to rely on touch rather than sight. This hands-on activity sparked meaningful discussions about accessibility and different ways people experience the world.

Additionally, graduation will be approaching soon – we will be taking pregraduation photos. Families, please check your email for more details.



What's math gotta do with it!

Our preschoolers in room 1 engaged in an exciting *Pumpkin Project* that combined creativity, science, and math through hands-on exploration.

The children made predictions about the pumpkin's size and weight. With the guidance of their teachers, they used a tape measure to determine its circumference, introducing measurement concepts in a meaningful and interactive way. This hands-on pumpkin exploration introduced several foundational math concepts

This activity fostered critical thinking, problem-solving, and creativity while strengthening fine motor skills and collaborative learning.



The children were thrilled to gather in the circle with a parent from our room eagerly participating in a puppet show and story time. Thank you to all the parents that took the time to come out to our pancake day.

Parental involvement in daycare plays a vital role in a child's development, fostering a strong connection between home and school.
