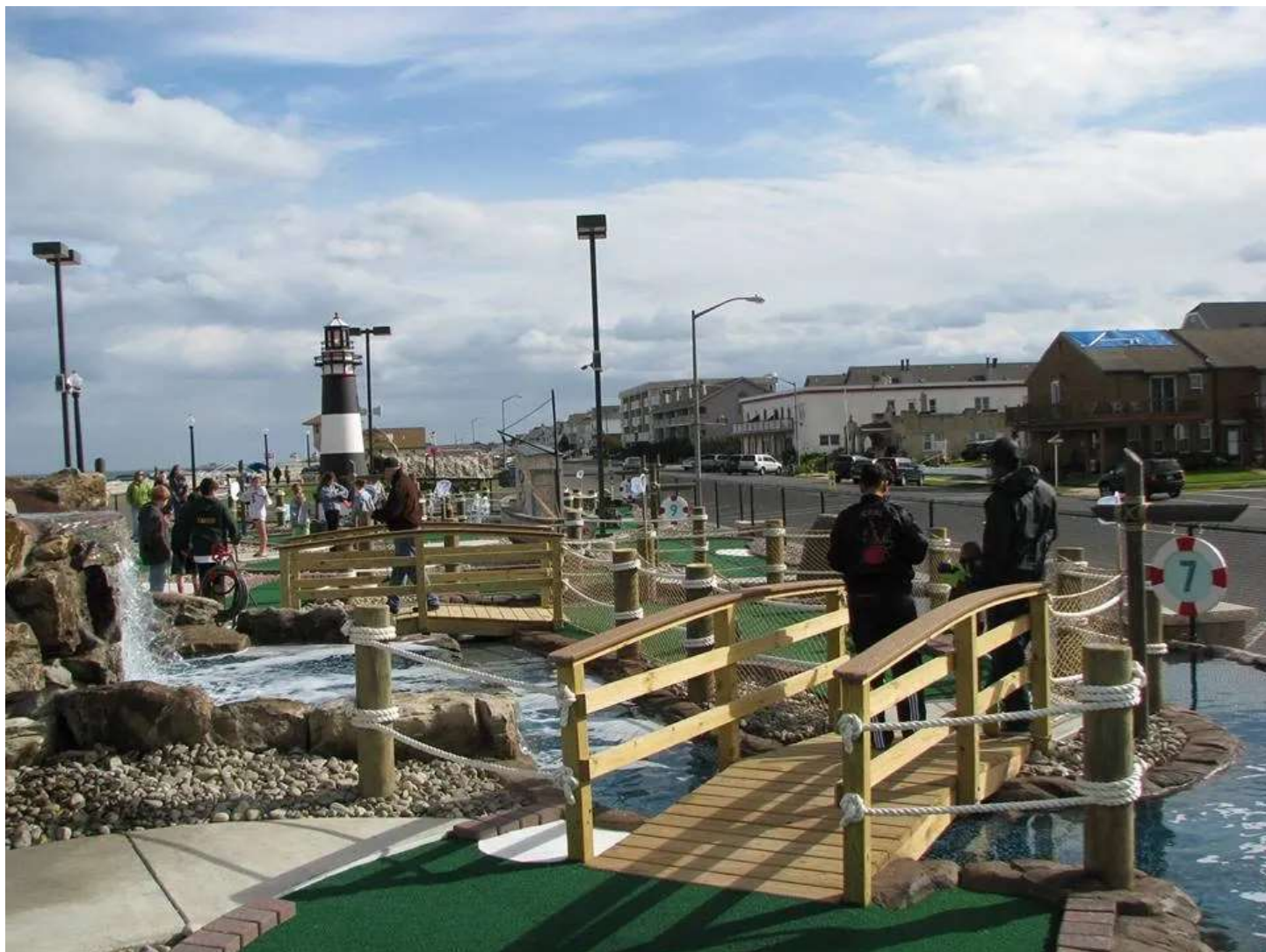

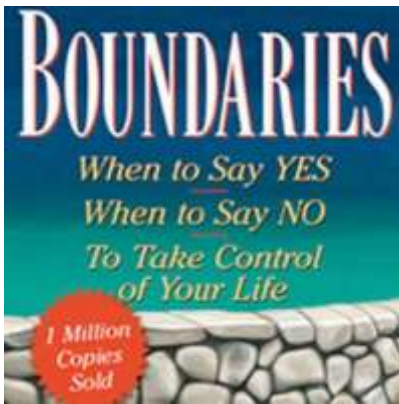
Swap and Drop!

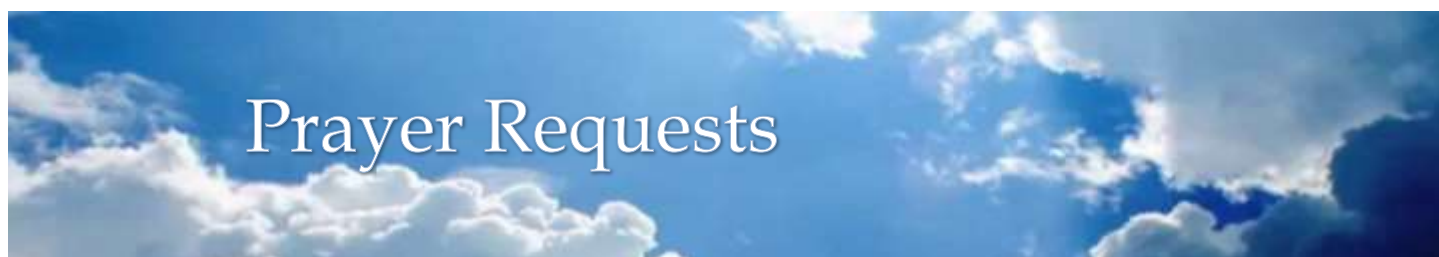
