I recently had the great pleasure to attend a 'Full Circle Discussion' at Colt's Neck Community Church. The speaker was a young man, named Moises. Moises volunteers as an ambassador for Operation Christmas Child, traveling around the country, speaking about his experience. He lived in an orphanage in El Salvador as a child. When he was 7 years old, he received a shoebox filled with toys, as well as a Bible story. That shoebox started his journey of coming to know Jesus. When he was a little boy, alone, Operation Christmas Child opened a door to a life with Jesus. Moises was adopted by a missionary family when he was 10 years old, and currently lives in Texas. He is a firefighter, and is getting married next year. His is a wonderful testimonial of this very important ministry! It was truly inspiring to hear his story! We kicked things off in September. 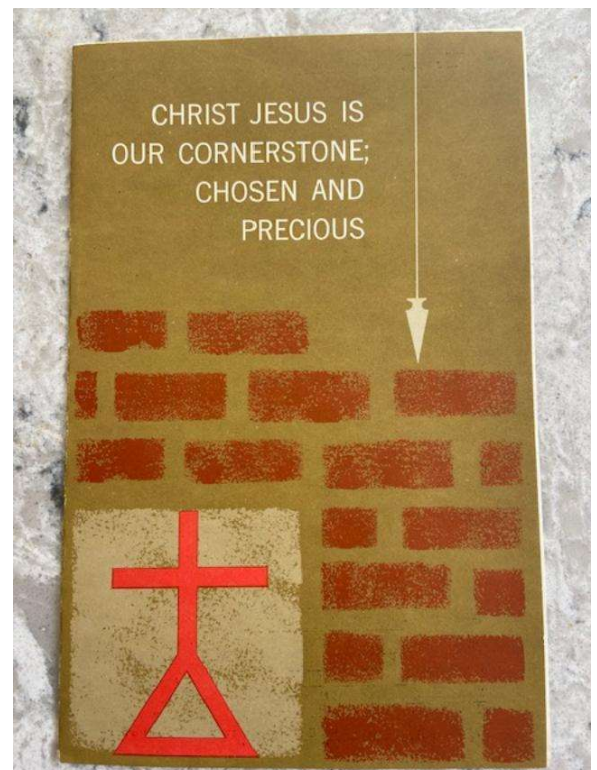
