### **BOARD MEETING**

The Board of Commissioners had a Regular meeting on March 11, 2025 with a quorum present. Housing Staff gave reports on daily operations. In Old Business the Commissioners approved revisions the PNHA to Collection Policy; and approved the PNHA Non-NAHASDA Lease Purchase Policy. Under New Business. Commissioners had discussion Virtual Meetings; set a meeting for the PNHA work plan with See Renewal; approved an amendment to the PNHA Sub-Contract with the Pawnee Nation: approved the request permission to share the PNHA data for presentation and viewing for the REPP Project.

The Board of Commissioners had a Regular meeting on April 8, 2025 with a quorum present. Housing Staff gave reports on daily operations. In New Business the Commissioners set a planning and development meeting with See Renewal on April 17th. In Executive Session the Commissioners also approved for the removal of Commissioner due to compliance concerns and unexcused absences.

### PLANNING AND DEVELOPOMENT



# RURAL ENERGY PILOT PROGRAM

The Pawnee Nation Rural Energy Pilot Program (REPP) has been busy finishing up with the installs of the sensors and the smart thermostats. We do have a few of the sensors left, please get with Alex if you would like to participate in the pilot program.

The project will soon be moving into phase 4 of the program, which is Distributed Energy Activities. The goals of phase 4 is the utility grid construction, community solar garden array, public access DER charging stations and the battery energy storage system. Alex is working with TDC on contracts for the placement of the charging stations.

As we moved into phase 4, we will keep everyone updated on the progress.



### MAINTENANCE ACTIVITIES

The maintenance staff have been cutting trees and removing debris on the 14 acres south of town. They have also been mulching the limbs for future use.

Continued work on a few rehabs at Littlesun Addition are on going. The staff just finished up Unit 113 and will now start work on Unit 116 which is a one (1) bedroom unit.

Staff have also started mowing and will be helping with the gardens. They will be getting around to filter changes and checking the smoke detectors monthly.






# HOUSING AUTHORITY NEWS

### AVAILABLE HOUSING

The Housing Authority is seeking tenants for 106 Eagle Chief Drive. This home is a three (3) bedroom home with one (1) full bathroom.

Eligibility requires the applicant to be within the HUD income guidelines, under the 80% median, be a Pawnee Tribal member or other federally recognized tribe, and submit documents for a background check. Monthly rent is income based, no higher than \$391 plus a \$300 security deposit. All of our applications are online at our website or can be picked up at the Housing Office.





The Housing Authority is seeking tenants for 219 Park Lane. This home is a trailer home with three (3) bedrooms, 2 full bathrooms, car port, and utility shed. This home is income based and to qualify you must be over the income guidelines of the 80% medium. Any community member may qualify for occupancy. The monthly rent for this unit is \$800 with a \$300 security deposit. Renter is responsible for all utilities and lawn upkeep. If you were issued a violation we hope that you will take serious the policies we have in place. A second violation will result in termination of your lease agreement and a fee of \$1,500 to have the unit cleaned from any smoke residue left behind in the unit.

### PNHA COOKING CORNER

### 5 MINUTE CHICKEN SALAD

Ingredients
2 cups chicken, shredded
1/2 apple, diced
1/4 cup sliced grapes
2 celery stems, sliced
1 seedless mini cucumber
1/4 cup raisins
1/4 cup plain yogurt
1/4 cup mayonnaise
1/4 tsp onion powder

Dashes of salt and pepper



Mix all ingredients and refrigerate before serving. Best on a croissant.

### GARLIC HERB ROASTED VEGGIES

Ingredients

I ib baby potatoes (red or gold), halved

I cup baby carrots (or sliced reg carrots)

I cup fresh green beans, trimmed

2 tbsp olive oil

3 cloves garlic, minced
1 tsp dried Italian seasoning

1/2 tsp smoked paprika

1/2 tsp salt

1/2 tsp black pepper



- 1. Preheat the oven to 400 degrees F
- 2. In a large bowl, combine all the ingredients and mix until everything is evenly coated
- 3. Transfer to a 9x13 inch baking pan that is lightly greased with cooking spray
- 4. Cover with aluminum foil, roast for 30 minutes, stir, uncover and back for another 30 minutes or until the vegetables are tender Garnish with fresh herbs like parsley before serving and enjoy



**UCCAS 5 CUP SALAD** 

Ingredients
I cup Sour Cream
I cup Pineapple Chunks
I cup Mandarin Oranges
I cup Maraschino Cherries

I cup Miniature Marshmallows

Directions - Drain the can of pineapple chunks, making sure to reserve a tablespoon of the juice.

Mix together the pineapple chunks, the reserved pineapple juice, mandarin oranges, sour cream, cherries and mini marshmallows.

Refrigerate for a few hours and serve.

### 7 LAYER DIP

16 oz refried beans mixed w/ 1 pkg taco seasoning

I cup lettuce

I cup Mexican cheese or sharp cheddar


