Crochet Gummy Bear Pattern

Notes:

Worked in continuous rounds.

Work each stitch into next single crochet stitch unless told otherwise.

sc = single crochet

sl st = slip stitch

Puff = Puff stitch with at least 5-8 loops on hook and closed with sc

hdc = half double crochet

dec = invisible sc decrease

Part One: The Body

Make magic circle

Round 1= 7sc into MC, sl st to close (7)

Round 2= 2sc in each sc of previous row (14)

Round 3= 1sc, puff, 4sc, puff, 7sc (16)

Round 4= 1sc, dec, 4sc, dec, 3sc, dec, 2sc (13)

Round 5= 1sc in each st (13)


Round 6= 3sc, dec, 3sc, dec, 3sc (11)

Round 7= 1sc in each st (11)


Round 8= 2sc, puff, 3sc, puff, 2sc, dec, (12)

Round 9= 1sc in each st (12).

Part Two: The Head



Round 10= 5sc, 2hdc in next st, 2hdc in next st, 2sc, dec, 1sc (13)

Round 11= 5sc, dec, dec, 4sc (11)

Round 12 = 1sc in each st (11)



Round 13= 4sc, puff, 3sc, puff, dec (12).

STUFF



Round 14= dec in each st (6)

Round 15 = fasten off and tie in ends*



*Tip: Make a Knot at the nose and tail for extra detail.

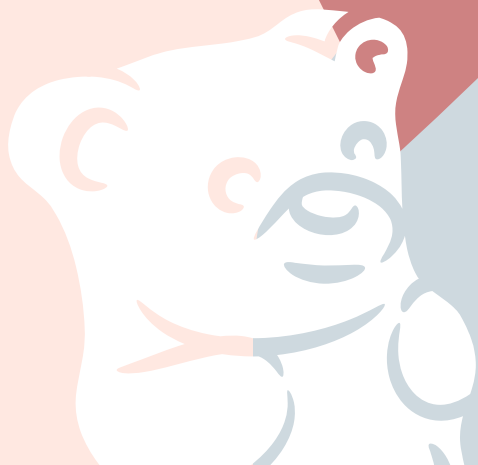
