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1. "Hot Work" or other activity such as welding, grinding or machining, including the use of gas-powered equipment designed for the purpose of thinning and/or maintaining property or equipment that is used that has a potential to be an ignition source shall follow the detailed "Hot Work Operational plan as provided and described below.
2. An inspection of the work site shall be conducted by the Fire Chief or his designee "Inspector", prior to the start of work, to approve the site location for safety and permitted operations.
3. Gas operated equipment used must be well maintained and equipped with a spark arresting style muffler.
4. There must be a water source under pressure capable of extinguishing the fire if the need arises as well as tools or another extinguishment equipment as approved by the inspector.
5. The cooking/work area must be cleared of combustibles or debris at a minimum of 10 feet in all directions.
6. A spotter must be present for large areas or where the operator cannot view 360° while working.
7. Person(s) conducting work authorized by this permit shall have a copy of this permit on site during the permitted work and shall produce a copy of this permit when requested to do so by Fire and/or other authorized personnel.
8. There must be a responsible adult in constant supervision at all times that any type of wood, pellet, or charcoal fired cooking apparatus is in use and until such fire is properly extinguished.
9. 24 hours in advance of event the Fire Chief or his/her designee will be contacted for any updates that would prevent the event from moving forward.
10. Designated smoking areas for businesses may be requested to be inspected and approved for use by fire and police officials. (Area must have minimum of 25' in all directions cleared of combustibles or an enclosed or semi-enclosed area that is non-combustible. An approved container designed specifically for cigarette butts that keeps them contained even if knocked over must be kept and maintained on site.\* Business owner is responsible for being aware of "Red Flag" Hours and not allow the use of the designated smoking areas during times listed as "Red Flag Warnings".)
11. In the event of an uncontrolled event/fire caused in the performance of this permit. The Permittee operating under this permit shall be at risk of citation and responsible for any and all related suppression costs.
