In order to create a safe, fun, and adventurous environment that allows every camper to participate in all opportunities, there are several things that CANNOT be brought to camp. Please ensure that your child does not bring the following items:

Hair Dryers / curling irons

Weapons - Rifles, Pistols, Knives, toy weapons prohibited

Tobacco products, alcohol, illegal/controlled substances

Flame or spark-producing items, lighters, matches, flints

Valuables—such as jewelry

If any of the above items arrive with a camper on the first day, the Camp Staff will return the item(s) to the parent or guardian for return home. Items found after the parent or guardian's departure will be removed from the camper's possession and held by the Camp Staff until the end of the Camp. For the safely and wellbeing of your child, please keep these items at home. Phone contact cards will be given to every parent or guardian upon arrival at the Camp. Cellular phone service is poor at the camp, but a land-line number will be available at all times during the Camp. Due to the possibility of rain in the summer months, damage to electronics is likely and therefore prohibited at Camp.
