- **ENTRIES CLOSE AT THE SUPERINTENDENT/SHOW SECRETARY'S OFFICE**, by 7:00pm on Wednesday, May, 18, 2022 after which time entries cannot be accepted, altered, canceled, or substituted.
- **ENTRY FORM MUST BE SIGNED** at the bottom by the owner or the owner's duly authorized agent, otherwise the entry cannot be accepted. Telegraph or telephone entries cannot be accepted. **OVERNIGHT deliveries** requiring **NO** signature only. Entries not on official AKC entry forms or photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE**.
- **MAKE ALL CHECKS & money orders payable to Erie Canine Event Services (ECES)**
- **RETURNED CHECKS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check.
- **OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE** for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. **PLEASE TYPE OR PRINT** carefully, the information on entry forms to eliminate errors. There are PDF fillable forms on the Erie website!
- **A RECORDING FEE OF \$50** is to be collected **on the first entry only for each dog, each day**. An **Event Service fee of \$3.00** will be required for each regular class each dog is entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial, Rally Trial or Tracking Test. These Fees are to be collected by the show giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. (AKC Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2).
- **NO ENTRY FEES** will be returned if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the management. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event the dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from the competition by action of the Show Committee.

- **DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING.** The Club or Show Secretary will not be responsible and is not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owner or agents are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.
- **DOGS MAY ARRIVE ANY TIME PRIOR** to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. All dogs present must be held on leash in hand except when being judged.
- **NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE** and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.
- **NO REFUND ON DUPLICATE ENTRIES.** Every effort will be made to find duplicate entries, but if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.
- **THE SHOW-GIVING CLUB, THE SHOW SECRETARY,** their agents and employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury, sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children not under the control of their parents or guardians.

- 3 (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. - 4 A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed.
