Preparatory Ādhivāsas & Devotee Participation

As a sacred prelude to the grand Samprokṣaṇa and Prāṇa Pratiṣṭhā Mahotsavam, a series of Ādhivāsa rituals will be performed for the Sila Mūrtis, led by our devoted Ācāryas and temple priests. These include sanctification and spiritual preparation of the deities through Dhānya, Jala, Kṣīra, and Taila Ādhivāsas, invoking the five elements and divine grace into every aspect of the ritual.

Dhānyādhivāsam

7th July (Monday) – 9th July (Wednesday) – From 9:00 AM to 8:00 PM

Rituals begin with Dhānyādhivāsam, where sacred grains symbolising prosperity and fertility envelop the deities in auspiciousness. This marks the spiritual awakening of the Bera Murthis and the utsava Mūrtis.

Jalādhivāsam

10th July (Thursday) – From 9:00 AM to 8:00 PM

The sanctified immersion of the deities in holy water (jala) continues over a day, allowing for meditative recitations and cleansing rituals that honour Varuṇa and the divine element of water.

Kşīrādhivāsam

11th July (Friday) - From 9:00 AM to 8:00 PM

The deities are lovingly bathed in sacred milk and fragrant substances. This ritual invokes nurturing energy and rejuvenation, preparing the Mūrtis for the final energising steps.

















Day 1 - Saturday 12th July 2025

Day 2 – Sunday, 13th July 2025

From 8:00 AM - Tailādhivāsam,

Pratiṣṭḥā Initiation of Vigrahas of Sri Śrīnivāsa, Sītā-Rāma, Vijaya Gaṇapati, Śiva-Pārvatī, Śaṇmukha with Valli and Deivanai, Goddess Vāsavi Māthā, and the Navagrahas.

This day holds special sanctity as the Pratiṣṭhā Day of Śrīnivāsa Perumāļ, during which the initial energisation (Prāṇa Pratiṣṭhā) of the primary Vigraha will be performed through Vedic homas and ritual procedures conducted by the officiating priests.

During the Pratistha of the Vigrahas:

- Punyāhavācanam
- Viśvaksena Pūjā
- Śrī Sudarśana Homa
- Pratișțhā of the Vigrahas
- Tailādhivāsam

From 8:00 AM - 8:00 PM:

Devotees are warmly invited to participate in the sacred Tailādhivāsam, a key ritual in the Prāṇa Pratiṣṭhā process. This seva involves the ceremonial anointing of all the Vigrahas, including the principal Śrīnivāsa Vigraha and the Śilā Mūrtis of all accompanying deities at CSPT, with consecrated oil (Taila).

This act of Taila Abhyañjana. anointing with herbal and spiritually charged oils is not merely a physical offering, but a deeply devotional practice. Through this act, devotees offer their seva (sacred service) and connect with the divine through sparśa (touch), mantra, and bhakti.

Day 3 – Monday, 14th July 2025

Morning from 9:30 AM:

Suprabhatam, Vāstu Śānti, Viśvaksena Pūjā, Mahā Saṅkalpam, Puṇyāha Vācanam, Pañcagavya Grahana, Ācārya & Rtvik Varanam.

Site purification and deity invitation rituals Dikpāla & Vāstu Pūjā – Worship of directional and land deities.

Evening from 5:30 PM:

Entry into the Yāgaśālā and establishment of the sacred fire.

Aṅkurārpaṇam (seed sowing), Kalaśa sthāpanam, Agni Pratiṣṭhā.

Series of homams, Vedic recitations, and Deepa Aradhana.

Prasādam distribution.

Day 4 - Tuesday, 15th July 2025

Morning from 8:00 AM:

Suprabhatam, Kalaśasandhi, Mahāśānti Homa Sarvadevatā Gāyatrī Homa, Pradhāna Homa.

Vimāna Kalaśa Sthāpanam – Installation of kalaśas on the temple tower.

Final oblation, Deepa Aradhana, Divya Prabandham, lunch **prasādam.**

Evening from 5:00 PM:

Go, Kanyā, Dampati, and Dīpa Pūjā.

Netra Unmīlanam – Opening of deity's eyes. Evening homas and Tīrthābhiṣekam for main deity

Prasādam distribution.

Day 5 – Wednesday, 16th July 2025

Morning (from 7:00 AM):

Suprabhātam, Kalaśasandhi, Pradhāna & Mūlamantra Homas.

Pūrṇāhuti (4th session).

Mahā Saṃprokṣaṇam (from 10:00 AM to 10:45 AM): – Grand Kumbhabhishekam in auspicious muhurtham.

Post-Samprokṣaṇam: Deepa Aradhana, Mantra Puṣpam, Vedic blessings.

Evening (from 5:00 PM to 8:00 PM) - Srinivasa Thirukalayanam

A grand Mahā Samprokṣaṇam (Consecration Ceremony) will be conducted by 10 expert Vedic scholars under the esteemed guidance of Śrī Raju Bhattachary, Chief Priest of the London Śrī Mahalakshmi Temple, and the learned Śrī Sree Ram Bhattachary, with guidance from Śrī Naganatha Sivacharya of the London Murugan Temple and the Chief Priest of CSPT. All rituals will be performed in accordance with the Śrī Vaiṣṇava and Śaiva Āgama traditions, culminating in the sacred Prāṇa Pratiṣṭhā, which ceremonially infuses divine energy into the temple deities and Vimānas.

We would like to deeply honour and appreciate the invaluable contribution of the priests and volunteers of CSPT, without whom this divine event would not be possible. Their tireless dedication, devotion, and service are the spiritual backbone of this great undertaking.

Following the Mahā Kumbhabhiṣhekam, our temple will enter a spiritually potent and transformative period of 48-day Maṇḍalābhiṣhekam, beginning 17th July 2025.

We humbly request your divine presence and heartfelt participation in this once-in-a-generation event, to receive the abundant blessings of Śrī Srinivasa Perumal and support the continuity of our sacred and timeless traditions.
