

DM Lawn Mowers

General Rules:

- Ages 12-17 must be accompanied BY a parent, no exceptions!!
- All ground rules will be gone over in a driver's meeting before the start of the derby.
- Mower inspection will be done by you the drivers. If you see something you don't like to bring it up at the driver's meeting.
- ALL DECISIONS MADE BY OFFICIALS ARE FINAL.
- NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES!
- DRIVER MUST WEAR HELMET, LONG PANTS, AND LONG SLEEVES.
- NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ACCIDENTS
- Roll-Overs- are allowed, as long as the driver is safe, and the mower is safe to continue on.
- For safety – Arms & Legs must remain inside at all times. If a mower does roll over, all drivers must STOP and wait until that driver uprights their mower and gets back on mower or gets off the track.
- Number are mandatory on each side of your mower so we can track the winners.

Building:

1. Mower MUST be a factory available mower (NO homemade frames).
2. No rear engine lawn mowers are allowed.
3. Engine must be factory lawn mower engine such as Briggs & Stratton, Tecumseh, etc.
4. All frame modification and frame reinforcing will be allowed.
5. Axles must be factory available mower axles, but any reinforcing and / or welding of spider gears is permitted.
6. Engine bay reinforcing is permitted but must be contained inside of the hood and must maintain factory bodylines.
7. All mowers must run a factory hood and fenders and have the hood either screwed or welded down to dash panel around driver's area. (If hood is fiberglass, you can make one out of sheet metal only but must be the same size as the fiberglass one.)
8. Mowers must have good brakes and forward and reverse gears at the start of the heat.
9. Gas tank must be secured and have a cap on it.
(Any gas at all leaking, you will be asked to shut down.)
10. Leg guards are mandatory and must be bolted and / or welded from rear fender to front of footrest or frame as long as it is under the hood.
11. A rear bumper is permitted but is not allowed to extend more than 4 inches out and it must stay in between the tires. Also, no spikes, sharp edges, or any protrusions allowed. (Bumper can be home made with I/H beam or square tubing.)
12. Re-gearing and changing the pulleys to increase speed is permitted and encouraged.
13. Any and all drive train modifications are permitted but must stay belt driven.
14. All mowers must use lawn mower type wheels. Tractor treads and cut tires will be permitted, but no tire chains or dual wheels will be allowed.
15. Mower decks must be removed.
16. All headlights and any other glass and plastics must be removed before you enter the pits.
17. No front bumpers. You can build up the front of the frame and underneath the grill to hit with. The front of the mower must have a smooth finish for safety.
