

Celebrating Our Fourth Year Together!

As we mark the fourth anniversary of the **Adult Learning Exchange Virtual Community**, we want to thank you for being part of this growing network of adult and continuing education professionals. Your engagement, support, and contributions have helped make this space a vibrant hub for learning, sharing, and innovation.

Reflecting on Four Years of Growth

As we celebrate this milestone, we take a moment to look back on all we've accomplished together since launching the [Adult Learning Exchange Virtual Community](#) in 2021.

- **Free Webinars:** Over the past four years, we've hosted **46 free webinars**, engaging hundreds of participants from around the world. In addition to individual sessions on timely topics—such as learning design, adult learning theory, AI tools, and inclusive practices—we also offered **five thematic series**. These series provided deeper exploration of key areas in adult and continuing education, allowing participants to build knowledge and apply concepts over multiple connected sessions.

- **A Snapshot of Our Webinar Journey:** As we mark four years of shared learning, we've begun analyzing data from the 27 webinars between April 2024 and May 2025. Early findings are promising, with registration numbers ranging from 9 to 94 participants, averaging just over 34 registrants per session. The results were exciting!

Our three most popular webinars were:

- **Methods for Facilitating Adult Learning**, held in June 2024, with an impressive 94 registrants.
- **Empowering Inclusive Learning: Leveraging AI for UDL Engagement**, hosted in January 2025, with 81 registrants.
- **Transforming Learner Expression: AI Tools for Dynamic UDL Action Strategies**, offered in March 2025, with 75 registrants.

Thank you to everyone who joined us—your participation and engagement have made this growth possible!

- **Podcast Episodes:** With **130 podcast episodes**, the Adult Learning Exchange Virtual Community has become a valuable space for thought leadership, professional reflection, and storytelling in adult and continuing education.
- **Online Forums:** We've grown to **16 online forums**, with the latest additions—[AI Literacy](#) and [Smart Learning Strategies](#)—responding to today's evolving educational landscape.
- **Consulting Partners:** Through **SCOC Consulting**, we've worked with educators, institutions, and organizations to co-create learning solutions grounded in adult learning principles and evidence-based practice. We have 16 consulting partners working with us, offering webinars, podcast episodes, and blog posts. We extend heartfelt gratitude to our consulting partners. - **Digital Library:** Our [Digital Library](#) continues to serve as a professional learning archive, featuring nearly **40 recorded webinars** and downloadable resources.
- **Local and Global Reach:** Our work has been enriched through collaboration with the **United States** and **international partners**, including the American Association for Adult and Continuing Education, the University of Oklahoma, PIMA, and Universidade Federal do Rio Grande do Sul, thereby expanding our collective understanding of lifelong learning in domestic and global contexts.
- **Community Contributions:** We've welcomed contributions from educators, administrators, researchers, practitioners, and graduate students, creating a space for cross-generational exchange, mentorship, and peer learning.




