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Artificial Intelligence (AI) in Education

Educators gained insights on advanced virtual training techniques, learning experience design (LXD), and creating engaging course syllabi in the interactive workshop *Crafting Captivating Course Syllabi Abstracts*. These sessions empowered participants to design more effective and learner-centered environments.



Academic and Professional Development

Supporting educators and researchers, this series included practical guidance on *Publishing Edited Books*, managing advisor-advisee relationships in *Maximizing Your Relationship with Your Major Advisor*, and balancing responsibilities in *Academic Multitasking: Finding Time to Write*. These sessions offered tools for personal and professional success in academia.

Book Talk Series

This popular series featured discussions on influential works in adult education and related fields. Titles like *Understanding the Adult Learner: Perspectives and Practices*; *Organization and Administration of Adult Education Programs*; *Assessment, Evaluation, and Accountability in Adult Education*; and *Career Pathways in Adult Education* provided valuable insights for

practitioners. The year concluded with webinars on *The Routledge Handbook of LGBTQ Identity in Organizations and Society* and *ChatGPT and Global Higher Education*, sparking meaningful conversations about identity, technology, and education.

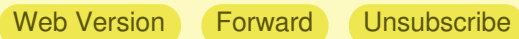
