3YRS MEMBERSHIP RENEWALS ARE NOW AVAILABLE!

Eliminate the yearly hassle of remembering to renew your American Legion membership by taking advantage of the new multi year (3 year) membership available to current and potential members. The annual Membership dues for Frank E. Robinson Post 586 will increase \$5 to \$40 per year on 1 July 2024 for the 2025 membership year (due to a \$5 increase at American Legion National) and another \$5 to \$45 per year for the 2026 Membership year (Due to an expected increase at American Legion, Dept of Ohio). Legionnaires can lock-in a three-year membership at the current rate of \$35 if you do it before 30 June by visiting legion.org/renew . You can take advantage of the Multi-year membership (2025, 2026 and 2027) even if you have already renewed your membership for 2024 to lock in today's rate for the

If you choose to participate in the 3 yr membership renewal here is how it will work. Keep in mind that you can only renew for 3yrs if you renew online by going to the Mylegion.org website. We cannot renew you for three year if you decide to send a check to the Post. Each year the Post will send you a membership card for the current membership year (probably in late July or early August). It's that simple, many of our Post members have taken advantage of this new program already. Sign up today and as alway we thank you for being a dedicated member of Frank E. Robinson Post 586.
