### THE TOMB OF THE UNKNOWN SOLDIER: A SYMBOL OF HONOR AND SACRIFICE

I wanted to share one of the most impactful places (in my opinion) a veteran can visit. If you've not been there, I definitely recommend making the trip. Located in Arlington National Cemetery in Virginia, the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier stands as a solemn tribute to unidentified American service members who died in combat. It represents all those who made the ultimate sacrifice but were never identified.

The tomb was dedicated in 1921, following World War I, when an unknown American soldier was interred there with full honors. Over time, unknown soldiers from World War II, Korea, and initially Vietnam were also honored in the tomb. However, the Vietnam Unknown was later identified in 1998 and reinterred, and that crypt now remains vacant.



The white marble tomb is engraved with the words: "Here rests in honored glory an American soldier known but to God."

What sets the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier apart is its 24/7 military guard, regardless of weather, holidays, or national emergencies. Since 1937, soldiers from the 3rd U.S. Infantry Regiment, known as "The Old Guard," have kept watch, performing a precise and symbolic changing of the guard ritual every hour (or half-hour during summer).
