- ◆ Have news of your own that you would like to share with the group? Just email your information to me and I will add it to the next available edition.

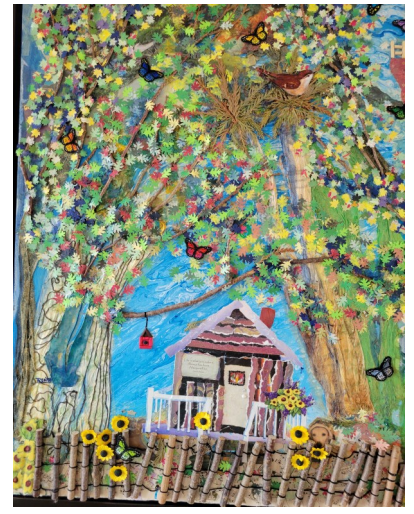
