Motion by Burke, second by Weyrich, to approve the Billboard Lease Agreement with Ted Kinzler for a term of 3 years at the cost of \$11,700, paying for it with the 3rd Cent Fund. All members present voting yes, motion carried.

Motion by Wiege, second by Davidson, to proceed with condemnation of the property located at 1216 Hooker Street, and authorize Gunderson, Palmer, Nelson, and Ashmore to compose and issue the notice of condemnation. All members present voting yes, motion carried.

Action 2021-106

Motion by Davidson, second by Weyrich, to approve lifting the open container ordinance at the Memorial Park Ballfield on Sunday nights from 6:00 PM till 12:00 AM, until snowfall. All members present voting yes, motion carried.

Action 2021-107

Motion by Weyrich, second by Wiege, to approve the quote of \$2,798.71 from Motorola for a new Police car radio system. All members present voting yes, motion carried.
