CITY OF WHITEWOOD Resolution Number 2021-06

WHEREAS, SDCL 34-20G-58 provides that a local government may enact an ordinance governing the time, place, manner, and number of cannabis establishments in a locality; and

WHEREAS, the City of Whitewood (the "City") is in the process of debating and passing a formal ordinance governing medical marijuana establishments;

WHEREAS, the City previously passed temporary Ordinance 2021-03 on June 21, 2021;

WHEREAS, the South Dakota Department of Health ("State") has since promulgated regulations;

WHEREAS, the City wishes to put in place temporary rules pending a formal ordinance and;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the City makes the following rules applicable to the issuance of new medical cannabis establishment licenses:

- 1. No medical marijuana establishments will be allowed in the City until the City enacts a formal set of ordinances regulating the time, place, manner, and number of cannabis establishments in the City;
- 2. The City will collect any applications or requests for a license ("applications") it receives until a formal ordinance is passed and forward those applications on to the State on **December 1, 2021, at 5:00 P.M.**;
- 3. The City will not issue a certification of compliance to any state level applicants until the City has enacted a formal set of ordinances regulating medical cannabis;
- 4. Any person, entity, or trust which applies to the State for licensure shall include this Resolution with their application and inform the State of the existence of the same and:
- 5. The City resolves to have a first reading of a medical marijuana ordinance by no later than **November 1, 2021,** which will allow for medical marijuana establishments.
- 6. This Resolution incorporates the terms of temporary Ordinance 2021-03 herein only to the extent the terms of said Ordinance 2021-03 do not conflict with this Resolution.

This Resolution shall become effective upon signing. This Resolution will be revoked two weeks after publication of a set of formal ordinances along with any other ordinances incorporated into the foregoing terms.
