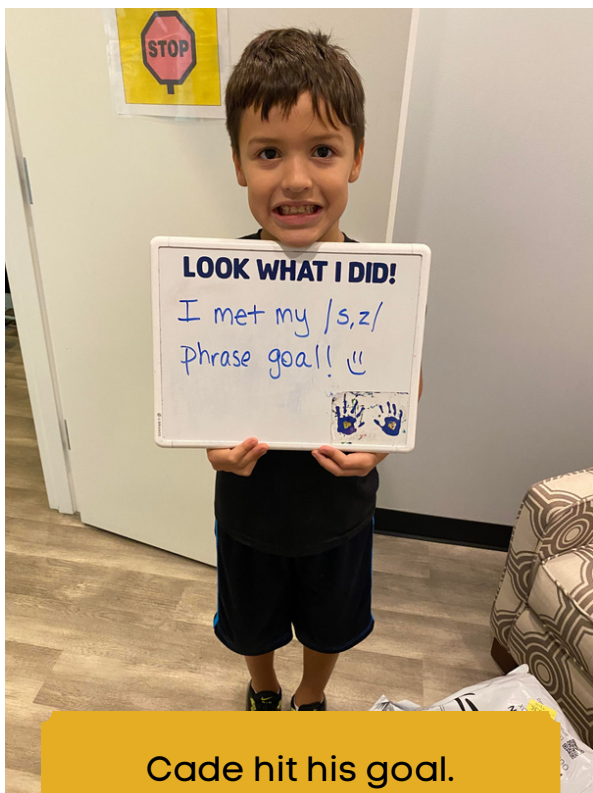

## **Christina's Corner**

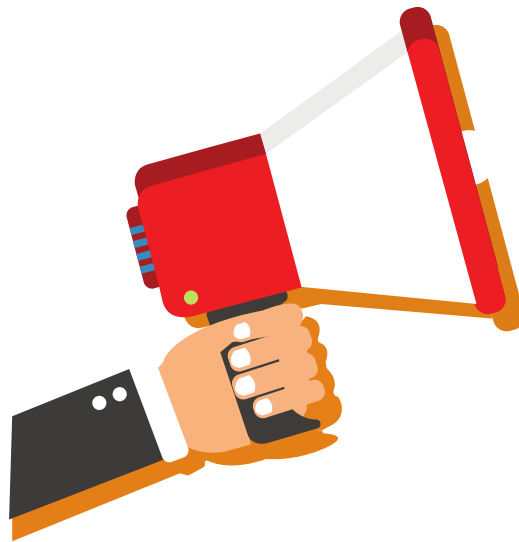
- Reminder: In case of inclement weather, the clinics follow the county government (not school system) closure policy. Tele therapy service will be offered during inclement weather closures.
